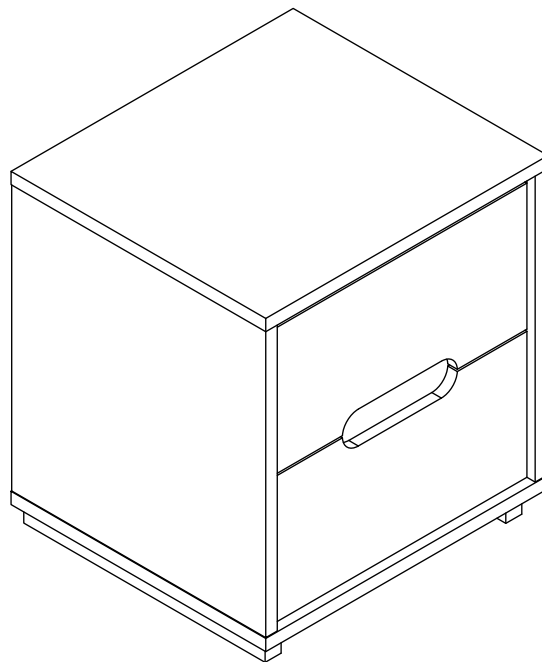

# Secure it!

Reduce the risk of furniture tip-over accidents



## WARNING: ENSURE THE WALL STRAP IS ATTACHED TO AVOID SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH.

To avoid any serious or fatal injury, a wall strap has been provided with this product to prevent toppling. We strongly recommend that this product is permanently fixed to the wall or other suitable surface. Fixing devices are not included since different surface materials require different attachments.

Please seek professional advice if you are in doubt of what fixing device to use.

To reduce the risk of furniture tipover:



Do not allow children to stand, climb or hang on furniture. It may topple and cause serious injury or death.

Do not place toys or other child appealing items on top of this furniture, and place heaviest items towards the bottom of the furniture.

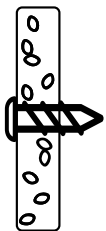


Do not open more than one drawer at the time.

Anchoring this product to a wall or other suitable surface is recommended. Check anchors regularly.

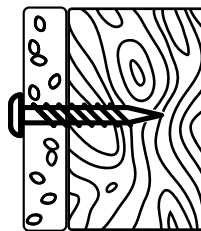
Avoid putting a TV on this product.

## Wall attachment guide



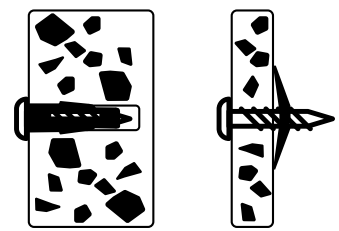
**For plasterboard**

Self drilling plasterboard anchor.



**For plasterboard**  
(with available wood stud)

**Securing method:**  
Screw inserted directly into stud.



**For masonry wall**

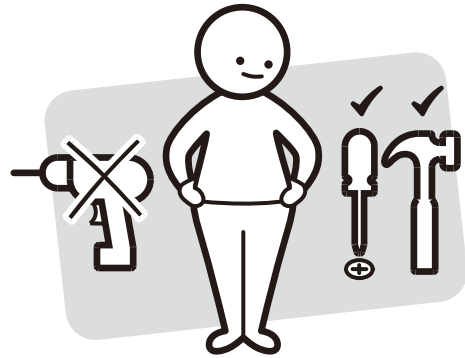
**Securing method:**  
Solid wall: Plug with screw  
Hollow wall: Spring toggle

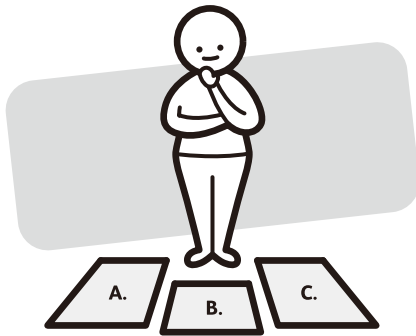
# Assembly checklist



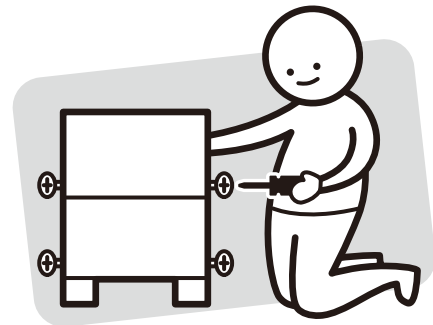
Read through the instructions carefully before you begin.



Make sure you have all the required tools. Never use power tools unless instructed.



Identify and lay out all of the components before you begin assembly.



Unless instructed, do not fully tighten screws until the item is fully assembled.

## Useful Information

- ! Never use power tools unless specifically instructed. They can damage your components or hardware if used incorrectly.
- ! The most common mistakes made during assembly are using the wrong hardware or getting components back to front.
- ! Always use a soft surface (such as carpet or cardboard) when assembling your product to avoid scratching or damaging the surface of the product.
- ! Bulky items such as wardrobes and bunk beds should be assembled in the room they will be used as they may not fit through a door once assembled.
- ! Never use any glue until you are certain that the parts belong together.
- ! Periodically check and re-tighten all fasteners. Check the product care label or website for product care instructions.

- 2 x Long Bottom Rails(P1);
- 2 x Short Bottom Rails (P2);
- 1 x Base Panel (P3);
- 1 x Left Side Panels (P4);
- 1 x Right Side Panels (P5);
- 1 x Back Panel (P6);
- 1 x Top Panel (P7);
- 1 x Upper Drawer Front (P8);
- 2 x Left Drawer Side (P9);
- 2 x Right Drawer Side (P10);
- 2 x Drawer Bottom ( P11);
- 2 x Drawer Back (P12);
- 1 x Lower Drawer Front (P13);







# Step 1

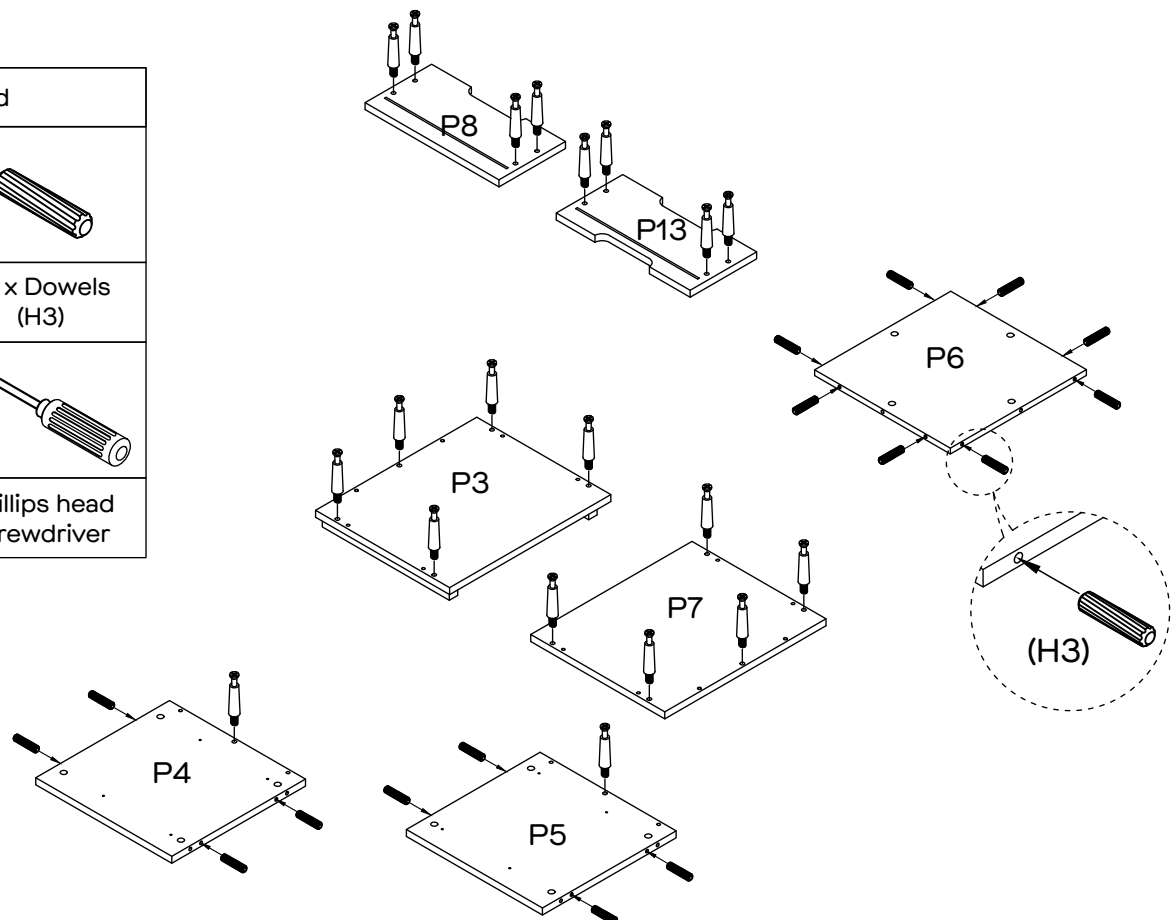
You will need	
	
8 x Bolts (H4)	
	
Phillips head screwdriver	



Attach 2 x Long Bottom Rails (P1), 2 x Short Bottom Rails (P2) to Base Panel (P3) with 8 x Bolts (H4) by using a Phillips head screwdriver.





# Step 2

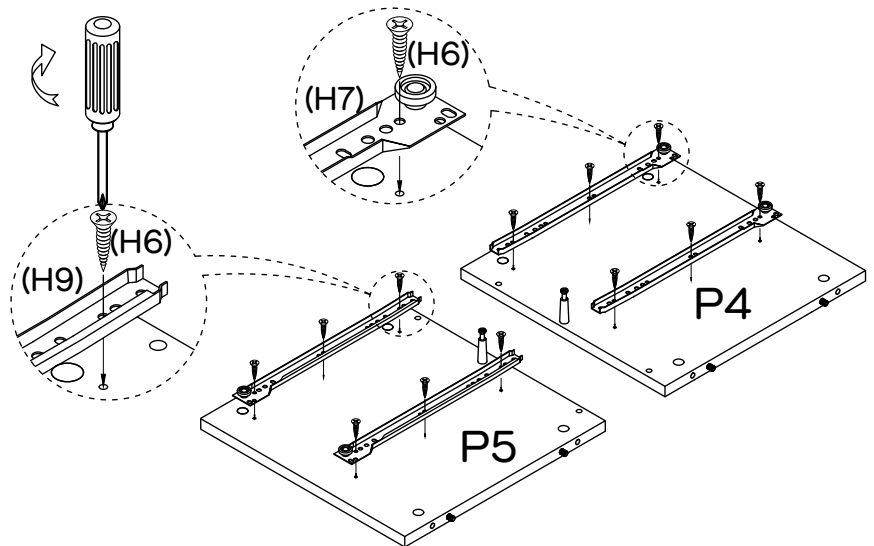
You will need	
	
20 x Cam Bolts (H1)	16 x Dowels (H3)
	
Hammer	Phillips head screwdriver



Insert 20 x Cam Bolts (H1), to panels (P3), (P4), (P5), ( P6), (P7), (P8), (P13) and 16 x Dowels (H3) to panels (P4), (P5), (P6) as shown.



# Step 3

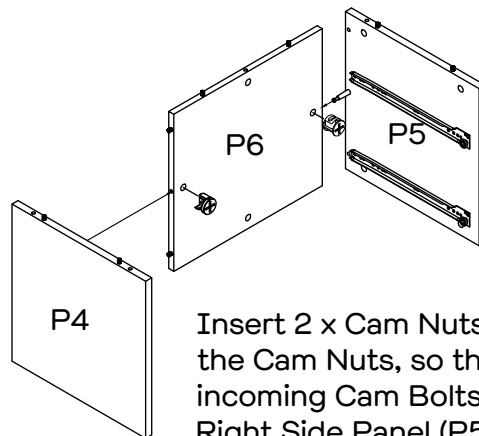
You will need	
	
12 x Screws (H6)	2 x Runner Tracks(H7)
	
2 x Runner Tracks(H9)	Phillips head screwdriver



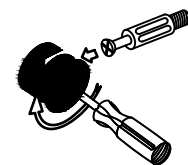
Attach 2 x Right Runner Tracks (H9) to Right Side Panel (P5) and 2 x Left Runner Tracks (H7) to Left Side Panel (P4) with 12 x Screws (H6) by using a Phillips head screwdriver.

# Step 4

You will need	
	
2 x Cam Nuts (H2)	Phillips head screwdriver





**This is how a cam nuts works.....**



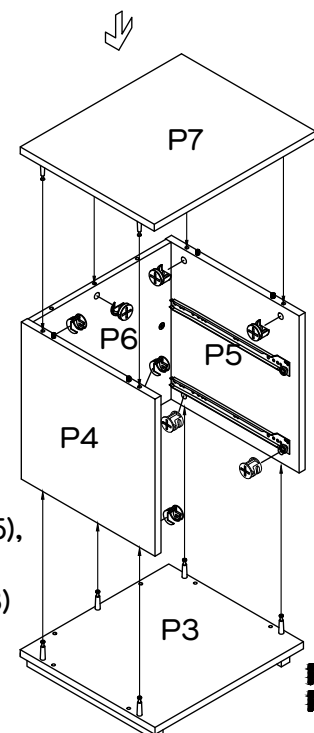
The head of the cam bolt goes into the open mouth of the cam nuts. You then turn the cam nuts so it tightens over the bolt.

Insert 2 x Cam Nuts (H2) into Back Panel (P6), rotate the Cam Nuts, so the arrow points towards the incoming Cam Bolts. Attach Left Side Panel (P4) and Right Side Panel (P5) to Back Panel (P6). Turn the Cam Nuts clockwise to tighten.

# Step 5

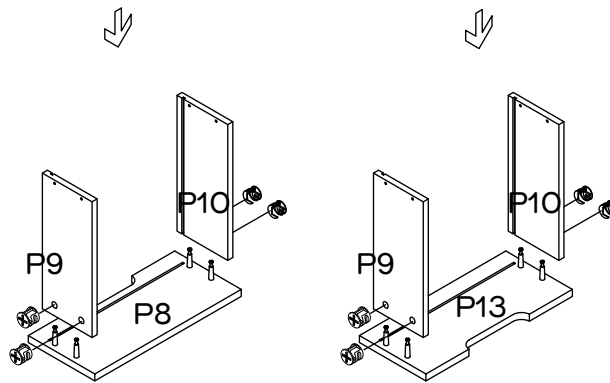
You will need	
	
10x Cam Nuts (H2)	Phillips head screwdriver

Insert 10 x Cam Nuts (H2) into holes on Left & Right Side Panels (P5), (P4) and Back Panel (P6), rotate the Cam Nuts, so the arrow point towards the incoming Cam Bolts, attach (P4), (P5), (P6) to (P7) & (P3) as shown, turn the Cam Nuts clockwise to tighten.



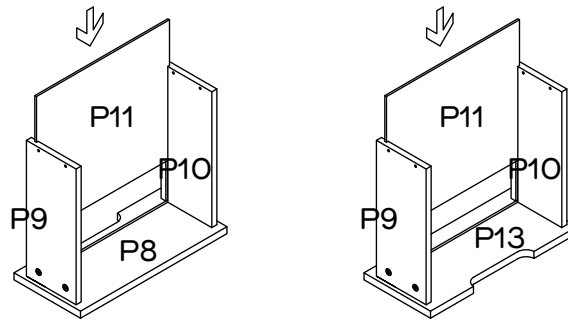
# Step 6

You will need	
8 x Cam Nuts (H2)	Phillips head screwdriver



Insert 8 x Cam Nuts (H2) into holes on (P9) & (P10), rotate the Cam Nuts, so the arrow point towards the incoming Cam Bolts. Attach Left Drawer Side (P9) and Right Drawer Side (P10) to the Drawer Front (P8) & (P13), turn the Cam Nuts clockwise to tighten.

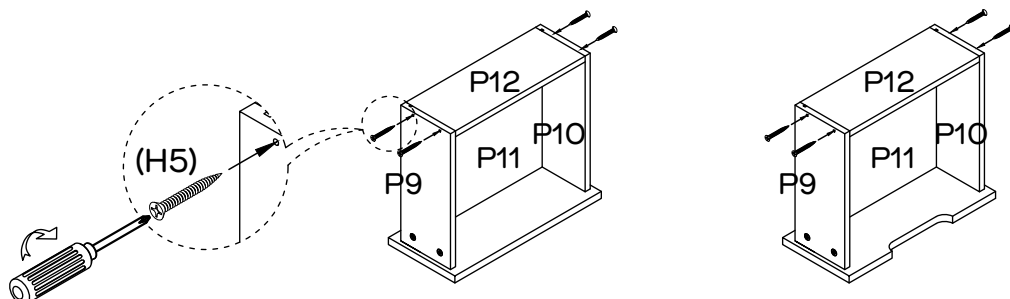
# Step 7



Insert the Drawer Bottom (P11) to the Drawer Frame as shown.




You will need	
8 x Screws (H5)	Phillips head screwdriver

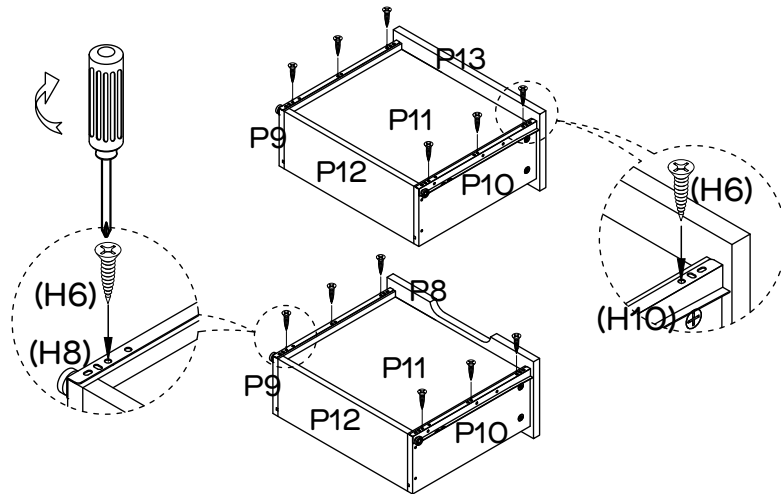


Attach the Drawer Back (P12) to the Left & Right Drawer Side (P9) & (P10) with 8 x Screws (H5) by using a Phillips head screwdriver.



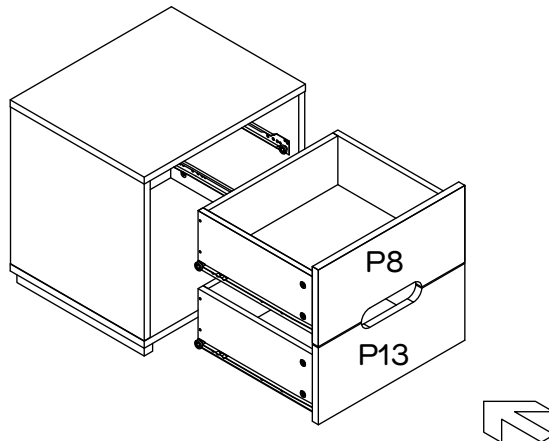
## Step 9

You will need	
	
12 x Screws (H6)	2 x Drawer Runners (H8)
	
2 x Drawer Runners (H10)	Phillips head screwdriver







Attach 2 x Left Drawer Runners to 2 x Left Drawer Side (P9) and 2 x Right Drawer Runners to 2 x Right Drawer Side (P10) with 12 x Screws (H6) by using a Phillips head screwdriver.

## Step 10

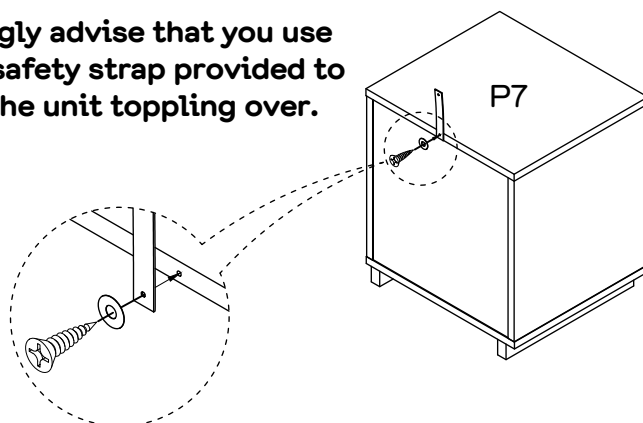


To insert the drawers, just gently put the left and right drawer runner on the Left and right track runner and push the drawers close.

## Step 11



You will need	
	
1 x Screws (H13)	1 x Washer (H11)
	
1 x Wall strap (H12)	Phillips head screwdriver

**We strongly advise that you use the wall safety strap provided to prevent the unit toppling over.**

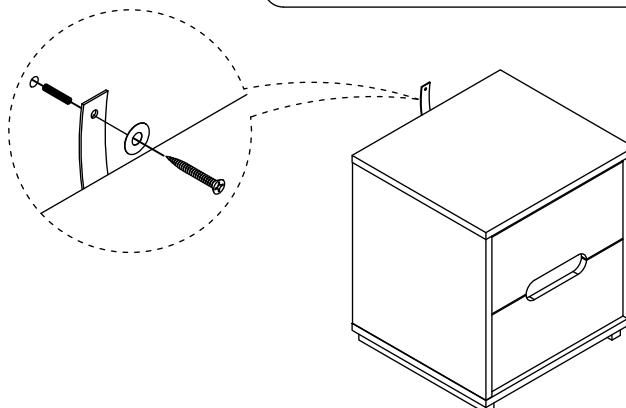


Attach the Washer (H11) to the top panel (P7) using 1 x screw (H13) and 1 x Wall strap (H12).

# Step 12

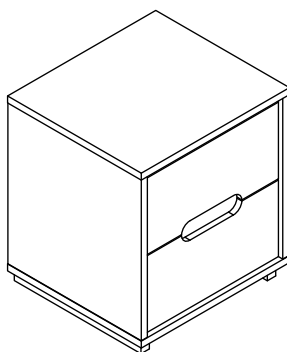
You will need	
	
1 x Washer (H11)	Phillips head screwdriver
Screw and wall plug which are not provided. Please use appropriate fixtures for your wall.	

Seek advice from a qualified trades person on how to attach this safety strap to your specific wall.



Move the Chest to final position. Attach the safety strap to the wall. Make sure it is firmly attached and make sure it is snug fit.
