


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
Assembly Checklist




Read through the instructions carefully before you begin.



Make sure you have all the required tools. Never use power tools unless instructed.




Identify and lay out all of the components before you begin assembly.




Unless instructed, do not fully tighten screws until the item is fully assembled.


Useful Information

- ! Never use power tools unless specifically instructed. They can damage your components or hardware if used incorrectly.
- ! The most common mistakes made during assembly are using the wrong hardware or getting components back to front.
- ! Always use a soft surface (such as carpet or cardboard) when assembling your product to avoid scratching or damaging the surface of the product.
- ! Bulky items such as wardrobes and bunk beds should be assembled in the room they will be used in as they may not fit through a door once assembled.
- ! Never use any glue until you are certain that the parts belong together.
- ! Periodically check and re-tighten all fasteners. Check the product care label or website for product care instructions.
- ! If you are having any difficulties assembling your product, missing any hardware or components please visit our website Help Centre for further assistance.
- ! Please see page 2 for any safety requirements or weight restrictions.





Attach 1 x CL Runner Track (H6) to Left Divider (P3) with 3 x Small Screws (H5). Attach 1 x CR Runner Track (H7) to Right Divider (P4) with 3 x Small Screws (H5).




Attach 4 x Cam Bolts (H3) into Dividers (P3, P4) using a Phillips head screwdriver. fantasticfurniture.com.au


Attach 8 x Cam Bolts (H3) into Legs (P7, P8, P9, P10) using a Phillips head screwdriver.

Step 4




Insert 4 x Small Dowels (H2) into the holes of Shelf Panel (P6) as shown. Insert 4 x Cam Nuts (H4) into into the holes of Shelf Panel (P6). Rotate the cam nuts so the arrows point towards the incoming cam bolts. Attach Dividers (P3, P4) to Shelf Panel (P6), then tighten the cam nuts using a Phillips head screwdriver.






Insert 4 x Small Dowels (H2) into the holes of Bottom Panel (P2). Attach Side Panels (P5) to to Bottom Panel (P2) with 2 x Inside Hexagonal Bolts (H18) using an Allen Key (H19).



Insert 4 x Small Dowels (H2) into the holes of Bottom Panel (P2). Attach Dividers (P3, P4) to Bottom Panel (P2) with 4 x Inside Hexagonal Bolts (H18) using an Allen Key (H19).






Insert 4 x Dowels (H1) into the holes of Bottom Panel (P2).

Insert 4 x Cam Nuts (H4) into the holes of Bottom Panel (P2) and Side Panels (P5).

Rotate the cam nuts so the arrows point towards the incoming cam bolts.


Attach Legs (P9, P10) into place, then tighten the cam nuts using Phillips head screwdriver




Insert 4 x Dowels (H1) into Bottom Panel (P2).

Insert 4 x Cam Nuts (H4) into the holes of Bottom Panel (P2) and Side Panels (P5). Rotate the cam nuts so the arrows point towards the incoming cam bolts. Attach Legs (P7, P8) into place, then tighten the cam nuts using Phillips head screwdriver





Twist 2 x Adjustable Support Legs (H17) to the bottom of Bottom Panel (P2) as shown. Hammer 4 x Plastic Glides (H21) on Legs (P7, P8, P9, P10).



Carefully turn the frame over to an upright position.

Slide Back Panels (P20) into the grooves in Legs (P9, P10) and Dividers (P3, P4).


Slide Back Panel (P11) into the grooves in Divider (P3) and Divider (P4).

Insert 8 x Dowels (H1) into Legs (P7, P8, P9, P10).

Insert 8 x Small Dowels (H2) into Dividers (P3, P4) and Side Panels (P5) as shown. fantasticfurniture.com.au




Attach 10 x Cam Bolts (H3) into Top Panel (P1) using a Phillips head screwdriver




Insert 10 x Cam Nuts (H4) into the holes of Dividers (P3, P4), Side Panels (P5) and Legs (P7, P8, P9, P10). Rotate the cam nuts so the arrows point towards the incoming cam bolts. Attach Top Panel (P1) to the frame and then tighten the cam nuts.






Attach 4 x Hinges (H15) to Doors (P12, P13) with 8 x Timber Screws (H16). Attach 2 x Handles (H13) to Doors (P12, P13) with 4 x Round Head Bolts (H14). Tighten Screws and Bolts using a Phillips head screwdriver.



Attach Left Door (P12) to LF Leg (P7) and Right Door (P13) to RF Leg (P8) with 16 x Timber Screws (H16) using a Phillips head screwdriver. Stick 2 x Rubber Stickers (H2O) to Dividers (P3, P4) as shown.









Screw 5 x Small Cam Bolts (H10) into Drawer Front (P14) with a Phillips head screwdriver.

Step 16






Insert 1 x Small Dowel (H2) into Drawer Front (P14) as shown.

Insert 5 x Small Cam Nuts (H11) into the holes of Drawer Sides (P15, P16) and Drawer Support (P19). Rotate the cam nuts so the arrows point towards the incoming cam bolts. Align the holes together, secure Drawer Sides (P15, P16) and Drawer Support (P19) into place, tighten the cam nuts using a Phillips head screwdriver.

Step 17




Slide Drawer Base (P17) in through the grooves on Drawer Sides (P15, P16).


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


Attach Drawer Back (P18) to Drawer Sides (P15, P16) and Drawer Support (P19) with 6 x Long Screws (H12), make sure that the groove lines up the whole way around the drawer. Tighten Screws using a Phillips head screwdriver.










Attach 1 x DL Runner (H8) to the bottom of Left Drawer Side (P15) and 1 x DR Runner (H9) to the bottom of Right Drawer Side (P16) with 4 x Small Screws (H5). Tighten Screws using a Phillips head screwdriver.






Attach 2 x Handles (H13) to Drawer Front (P14) with 4 x Round Head Bolts (H14). Tighten round head bolts using a Phillips head screwdriver.





Slide the drawer into the cabinet.





TO ADJUST YOUR DOORS TO MAKE THE GAPS MORE EVEN


STEP 1

Open the door.




STEP 2

Adjust the door move in or out a little




Loosen the screw indicated a little, adjust the hinge to right position (see step 2a & 2b), then tighten screw.

STEP 2a MOVE DOOR IN



Push the hinge back a little.

STEP 2b MOVE DOOR OUT



Pull the hinge forward a little.


STEP 3 To adjust the gap between door and leg

Door


Top panel

Loosen or tighten the screw indicated a little to adjust the gap between door and leg (see step 3a & step 3b)

STEP 3a MOVE DOOR RIGHT STEP 3b MOVE DOOR LEFT



Turn the screw clockwise a litte as shown to make the gap big.



Turn the screw counterclockwise a litte as shown to make the gap small.
