

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Assembly checklist



Read through the instructions carefully before you begin.



Make sure you have all the required tools. Never use power tools unless instructed.



Identify and lay out all of the components before you begin assembly.



Unless instructed, do not fully tighten screws until the item is fully assembled.

Useful Information

!Never use power tools unless specifically instructed. They can damage your components or hardware if used incorrectly.

!The most common mistakes made during assembly are using the wrong hardware or getting components back to front.

!Always use a soft surface (such as carpet or cardboard) when assembling your product to avoid scratching or damaging the surface of the product.

!Bulky items such as wardrobes and bunk beds should be assembled in the room they will be used in as they may not fit through a door once assembled.

!Never use any glue until you are certain that the parts belong together.

! Periodically check and re-tighten all fasteners. Check the product care label or website for product care instructions.







Flat head screwdriver; Phillips head screwdriver; Mallet


Part list

Box 1: Top Panel (P1); Bottom Panel (P2); Left Side Panel (P3); Right Side Panel (P4); 2x Drawer Front (P5); 2x Drawer Left Side (P6); 2x Drawer Right Side (P7); 2x Drawer Back Panel (P8); 2x Drawer Base (P9); Back Panel (P10); 4x Leg (P11); Hardware.









Screw 4 x Big Cam Bolts (H1) into Top Panel (P1) as shown.

Step 2


Separate the Slide Runners (H15-2) and Slide Tracks (H15-1) from Slide (H15) by following the steps below:


Extend the Slide Runner all the way forward.

Press the plastic release lever of the slide down and pull the Slide Runner (H15.2) completely out

(H15-2) completely out.









Insert 2 x Big Wood Dowels (H4) into Left Side Panel (P3). Screw 2 x Big Cam Bolts (H1) into Left Side Panel (P3).

Attach 2 x Slide Tracks (H15-1) onto Left Side Panel (P3) with 6 x Screws (H7).








Insert 2 x Big Wood Dowels (H4) into Right Side Panel (P4). Screw 2 x Big Cam Bolts (H1) into Right Side Panel (P4). Attach 2 x Slide Tracks (H15-1) onto Right Side Panel (P4) with 6 x Screws (H7).

Step 4




Insert 4 x Big Wood Dowels (H4) into Bottom Panel (P2).



Position Left Side Panel (P3) and Right Side Panel (P4) onto Bottom Panel (P2), so that their grooves are aligned.

Insert 4 x Big Cam Nuts (H2) into Bottom Panels (P2) and turn clockwise to lock.






Fix each Metal Leg (P11) to Bottom Panel (P2) with 3 x Bolts (H3) using Allen Key (H12).

With help, turn the assembled unit over carefully.









Slide Back Panel (P10) into the grooves as shown.

Step 8









Position Top Panel (P1) onto Side Panel (P3) & (P4) and Back Panel (P10). Make sure the Back Panel (P10) fits into the groove under Top Panel (P1).


Insert 4 x Big Cam Nuts (H2) into Side Panels (P3) & (P4) and turn clockwise to lock.





Fix the Back Panel Connectors (H14) with Screws (H13) as shown.






Attach 1x Drawer Side Panel (P6) and 1x Drawer Side Panel (P7) to 1x Drawer Back Panel (P8) with 4 x Screws (H6), so that their grooves are at the same side.

Repeat for all drawer panels.


Step 12



Slide 1x Drawer Base (P9) into the grooves in the Drawer Panels (P6), (P7) and (P8). Repeat with the other Drawer Base (P9).







Position Drawer Front (P5) onto Drawer Sides (P6) & (P7).

Rotate 1x Small Cam Nut (H9) so the arrow points towards the incoming cam bolt and insert the Small Cam Nut (H9) into Drawer Side Panel (P6) or (P7).


Repeat with the remaining 1 x Small Cam Nut (H9).

Turn Small Cam Nuts (H9) clockwise to lock.

Repeat with other Drawer Front (P5).







Attach 1x Metal Handle (H11) onto each Drawer Front (P5) with 2x Screws (H8) using a Phillips head screwdriver. Do not over-tighten the screws (H8).














Push Middle Track in.








Position Drawer so that Slide Runner (H15-2) aaligns with Slide Track (H15-1) as shown. Gently push drawer into the closed position.




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If the Bedside is not level, you can adjust the height of each Leg by turning the feet of Legs clockwise or counter-clockwise.
