

Product Care & Maintenance



Sofa and Lounges

We want you to enjoy your Fantastic Furniture for as long as possible, with simple care and maintenance you will extend the life of your furniture.

Sofas and Lounges

Keep dust free, as dust settles it can become abrasive and cause damage to the cover.

Unless otherwise stated do not remove covers for cleaning. Blot food and liquid spills immediately with a white clean dry cloth. Avoid rubbing and allow to dry thoroughly in the shade away from direct heat and sunlight. If further cleaning is required use a clean cloth with a non coloured soap solution made from soap flakes and warm water. Professional cleaning is also recommended.

All covers will fade over time; however protect your furniture from direct sunlight to avoid rapid and excessive fading from our sun's harmful UV rays. Keep away from direct heat sources such as fireplaces and heaters. Avoid contact with chlorine, chlorine stains are permanent and will change the colour of materials. Be careful of wet swimmers and towels after a swim in the pool!

Check all your furniture hardware (screws, nuts and bolts) to make sure they are not loose and tighten regularly to help keep the product looking its best for years to come. These care instructions are a general guide – for any specific instructions check your product care label.

Fabric Upholstered Furniture

For general maintenance regularly vacuum on a low suction setting. Please note, wet towels and clothing can also cause mould growth and dye transfer as well as leave watermarks on fabric. Ensure you follow the manufacturer's instructions. Professional cleaning is also recommended.

Bonded Leather*, Vinyl and PVC Furniture

For general maintenance regularly dust with a clean dry duster Use only care products recommended for bonded leather*, vinyl or PVC. Ensure you follow the manufacturer's instructions. Professional cleaning is also recommended.

*Bonded leather is predominantly made from synthetic materials with a fabric core backing of leather fibres.
