




Fix 8 x small bolts (H1) into headboard & footboard (P1 & P2) about 5mm with the large allen key (H8) or by hand.

Do not fully tighten, as you need to slot on the side rails in the next step.


Step 2



Fix 1 \times u-bracket (H5) to headboard (P1) with 4 \times small wood screws (H3) and fix 1 \times u-bracket (H5) to footboard (P2) with 4 \times small wood screws (H3), tightening with a phillips head screwdriver.



Step 3 Required Headboard (P1) Footboard (P2) Slot on the 2 x side rails (P3) on to the bolts (H1) on the headboard (P1) and footboard (P2) as shown.





Tighten 8 x small bolts (H1) by using the large allen key (H8). Ensure the bolts (H1) are fully tightened.





Put the center rail (P4) into u-brackets (H5) on the headboard (P1) & footboard (P2). Tighten 2 x large bolts (H2) into the center rail (P4) & u-brackets (H5). Then tighten with 2 x hex nuts (H6) using the small allen key (H7) and spanner.



Fix the slats (P5) on to both side rails (P3) by using 28 x large wood screws (H4). Then fix center of each slat (P5) to center rail (P4) by using 14 x large wood screws (H4). Secure by tightening wood screws (H4) with a phillips head screwdriver.







Table Top (P1), Left Side Panel (P2), Right Side Panel (P3), Front Rails (P4), Lower Rear Rail (P5), Upper Rear Rails (P6), Back Panels (P7), Back Panel With Warning Label (P7A), Front Drawer Panels (P8), Left Drawer Side Panels (P9), Right Drawer Side Panels (P10), Back Drawer Panels (P11), Bottom Drawer Panels (P12), Drawer Support Panels (P13), Upper Front Rail (P14), Hardware Pack.








Insert 54 \times cam bolts (H1) into the panels as shown, tighten with a phillips head screwdriver.






Insert 22 \times large wood dowels (H3) to the rails & panels as shown by hand or gently using a soft headed mallet.




Insert 5 x large cam nuts (H2) into the front rails (P4) & 1 x cam nut (H2) into upper front rail (P14). Rotate the cam nuts (H2) so the arrows point towards the incoming cam bolts. Attach the 5 x front rails (P4) & upper front rail (P14) to the left side panel (P2). Turn the cam nuts (H2) on the rails (P4 & P14) clockwise with a phillips head screwdriver to lock into position.




Rotate the cam nuts (H2) so the arrows point towards the incoming cam bolts. Attach the rails (P5 & P6) to the left side panel (P2).

Turn the cam nuts (H2) on the rails (P5 & P6) clockwise with a phillips head screwdriver to lock into position.



Slot in 2 x back panels (P7) into the grooves of the panels (P5, P6 & P2).






Insert 9 x large cam nuts (H2) into rails (P4, P5, P6 & P14). (P5)

Rotate the cam nuts (H2) so the arrows point towards the incoming cam bolts.


Attach the right side panel (P3) to the rails (P4, P5, P6 & P14).

Turn the cam nuts (H2) on the rails (P4, P5, P6 & P14) clockwise with a phillips head screwdriver to lock into position.



Slot in the back panel (P7A) into the grooves of panels (P2, P3 & P6). The warning label should be facing the back.






Insert 6×1 large cam nuts (H2) into the left 8×1 right side panels (P2 8×1) and upper front rail (P14).

Rotate the cam nuts (H2) so the arrows point towards the incoming cam bolts. Attach the top panel (P1) to the panels (P2, P3, P7A & P14).


Turn the cam nuts (H2) on the panels (P2, P3, & P14) clockwise with a phillips head screwdriver to lock into position.






Insert 4 x small wood dowels (H7) to the left & right drawer side panels (P9 & P10) as shown by hand or gently using a soft headed mallet.

Step 10




Insert 4 x small cam nuts (H6) into the left & right drawer side panels (P9 & P10). Rotate the cam nuts (H6) so the arrows point towards the incoming cam bolts. Attach the front drawer panel (P8) to the left & right drawer side panels (P9 & P10). Turn the cam nuts (H6) on panels (P9 & P10) clockwise with a phillips head screwdriver to lock into position.






Slot in bottom drawer panel (P12) into the grooves of the left & right drawer side panels (P9 & P10) and also to the front drawer panel (P8).

Step 12




Insert 2 x small cam nuts (H6) into the drawer support panel (P13). Rotate the cam nuts (H6) so the arrow point towards the incoming cam bolts. Attach the drawer support panel (P13) to the front drawer panel (P8). Turn the cam nuts (H6) on drawer support panel (P13) clockwise with a phillips head screwdriver to lock into position.






Fix the back drawer panel (P11) to the left & right drawer side panels (P9 & P10) using 4 x wood screws (H4) tightening with a phillips head screwdriver.




Attach the back drawer panel (P11) to the drawer support panel (P13). Turn the cam nut (H6) on drawer support panels (P13) clockwise with a phillips head screwdriver to lock into position. Repeat step 9 to 14 for the 4 remaining drawers.






Insert the 5 drawers into the unit.

Step 16




Insert the $12 \times buckles$ (H5) into the frame as shown with a phillips head screwdriver.










Insert 22 x cam bolts (H1) to panels as shown. Secure by tightening cam bolts (H1) with a phillips head screwdriver.






Rotate the cam nuts (H2) so the arrows point towards the incoming cam bolts. Attach the 3 x front rails (P4) to the left side panel (P2).


Turn the cam nuts (H2) on the front rails (P4) clockwise with a phillips head screwdriver to lock into position.

Step 4



Rotate the cam nut (H2) so the arrow point towards the incoming cam bolts. Attach the rear rail (P5) to the left side panel (P2).

Turn the cam nut (H2) on the rear rail (P5) clockwise with a phillips head screwdriver to lock into position.




Insert 2 x cam nuts (H2) into the shelf panel (P7).

Rotate the cam nuts (H2) so the arrows point towards the incoming cam bolts.

Attach the shelf panel (P7) to the left side panel (P2).

Turn the cam nuts (H2) on the shelf panel (P7) clockwise with a phillips head screwdriver to lock into position.

Step 6




Insert 6 x cam nuts (H2) into rails (P4 & P5) & panel (P7).

Rotate the cam nuts (H2) so the arrows point towards the incoming cam bolts. Attach the right side panel (P3) to the rails (P4 & P5) & panel (P7).


Turn the cam nuts (H2) on the rails (P4 & P5) & panel (P7) clockwise with a phillips head screwdriver to lock into position.





Slot in back panel (P6) into the grooves of the left & right side panel (P2 & P3) and also rear rail (P5). The warning label should be facing the back.

Step 8



Insert 4 x cam nuts (H2) into the right & left side panel (P2 & P3).


Rotate the cam nuts (H2) so the arrows point towards the incoming cam bolts.

Attach the top panel (P1) to the right & left side panel (P2 & P3).


Turn the cam nuts (H2) on the right & left side panel (P2 & P3) clockwise with a phillips head screwdriver to lock into position.

Ensure the back panel (P6) slots into the groove of the top panel (P1).






Insert 4 x cam nuts (H2) into the left & right drawer side panels (P9 & P10). Rotate the cam nuts (H2) so the arrows point towards the incoming cam bolts. Attach the front drawer panel (P8) to the left & right drawer side panels (P9 & P10). Turn the cam nuts (H2) on panels (P9 & P10) clockwise with a phillips head screwdriver to lock into position.




Slot in bottom drawer panel (P12) into the grooves of the left & right drawer side panels (P9 & P10) and also to the front drawer panel (P8).






Insert 2 x small cam nuts (H2) into the drawer support panel (P13). Rotate the cam nuts (H2) so the arrow point towards the incoming cam bolts. Attach the drawer support panel (P13) to the front drawer panel (P8). Turn the bottom cam nut (H2) on drawer support panel (P13) clockwise with a phillips head screwdriver to lock into position.

Step 12




Fix the back drawer panel (P11) to the left & right drawer side panels (P9 & P10) using 4 x wood screws (H4) tightening with a phillips head screwdriver.






Attach the back drawer panel (P11) to the drawer support panel (P13). Turn the top cam nut (H6) on drawer support panel (P13) clockwise with a phillips head screwdriver to lock into position.

Step 14



Insert the drawer into the unit.







Insert the 4 x buckles (H5) into the frame as shown with a phillips head screwdriver.

Step 16



Move the bedside to its final position and then secure the wall strap to the wall. Ensure it is firmly attached. The screws and wall plugs are not provided.
