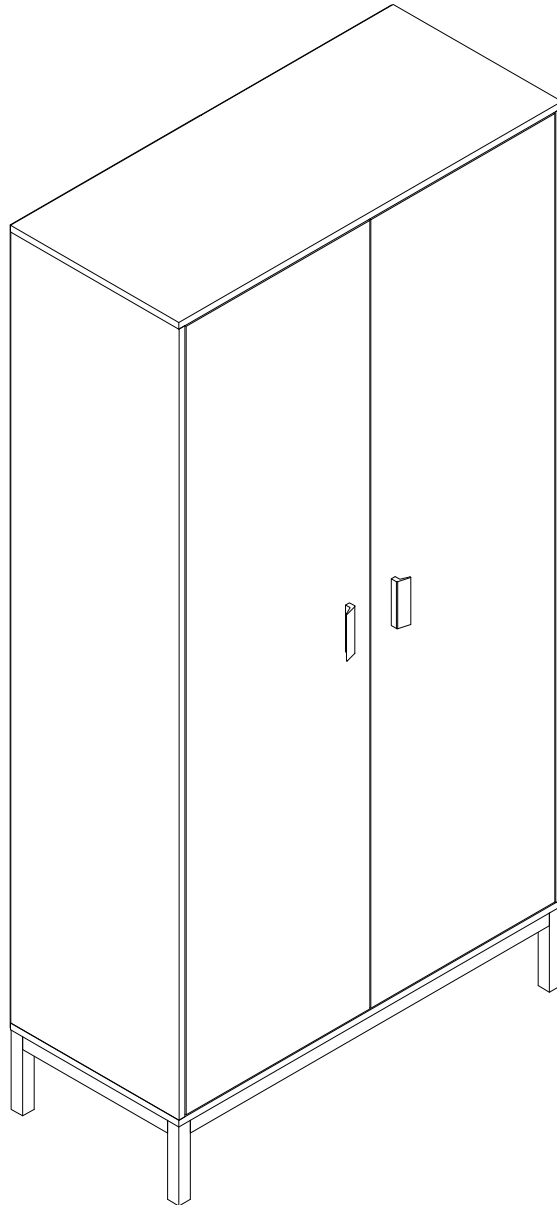

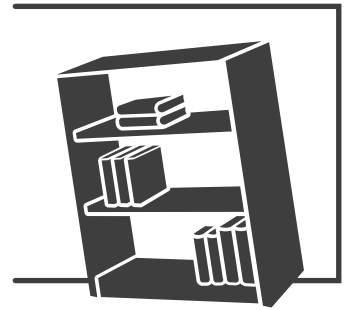

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# Secure it!

To avoid any serious or fatal injury, a wall strap has been provided with this product to prevent toppling. We strongly recommend that this product is permanently fixed to the wall or other suitable surface. Fixing devices are not included since different surface materials require different attachments. Please seek professional advice if you are in doubt of what fixing device to use.

To reduce the risk of furniture tipover:

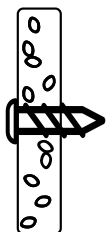


- Do not allow children to stand, climb or hang on furniture. It may topple and cause serious injury or death.
- Do not place toys or other child appealing items on top of this furniture, and place heaviest items towards the bottom of the furniture.



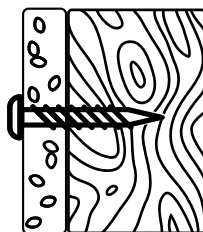
- Do not open more than one drawer at the time.
- Anchoring this product to a wall or other suitable surface is recommended. Check anchors regularly.
- Avoid putting a TV on this product.

## Wall attachment guide



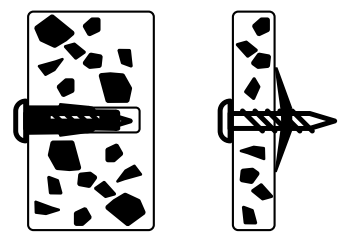
**For plasterboard**

**Securing method:**  
Self drilling plasterboard anchor.



**For plasterboard**  
(with available wood stud)

**Securing method:**  
Screw inserted directly into stud.



**For masonry wall**

**Securing method:**  
Solid wall: Plug with screw  
Hollow wall: Spring toggle

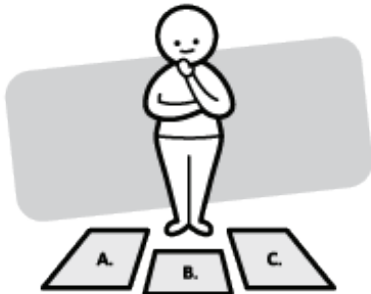
# Assembly Checklist



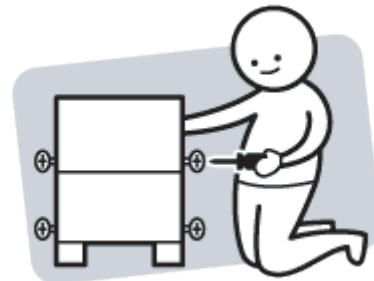
Read through the instructions carefully before you begin.



Make sure you have all the required tools. Never use power tools unless instructed.



Identify and lay out all of the components before you begin assembly.



Unless instructed, do not fully tighten screws until the item is fully assembled.

## Useful information

- ! Never use power tools unless specifically instructed. They can damage your components or hardware if used incorrectly.
- ! The most common mistakes made during assembly are using the wrong hardware or getting components back to front.
- ! Always use a soft surface (such as carpet or cardboard) when assembling your product to avoid scratching or damaging the surface of the product.
- ! Bulky items such as wardrobes and bunk beds should be assembled in the room they will be used in as they may not fit through a door once assembled.
- ! Never use any glue until you are certain that the parts belong together.
- ! Periodically check and re-tighten all fasteners. Check the product care label or website for product care instructions.
- ! If you are having any difficulties assembling your product, missing any hardware or components please visit our website Help Centre for further assistance.
- ! Please see page 2 for any safety requirements or weight restrictions.

# Step 1

You will need	
	
8X Hinges (H4)	16X Screws (H5)
	
2X Metal Handle (H6)	4X Screws (H7)
	
Phillips head Screwdriver	




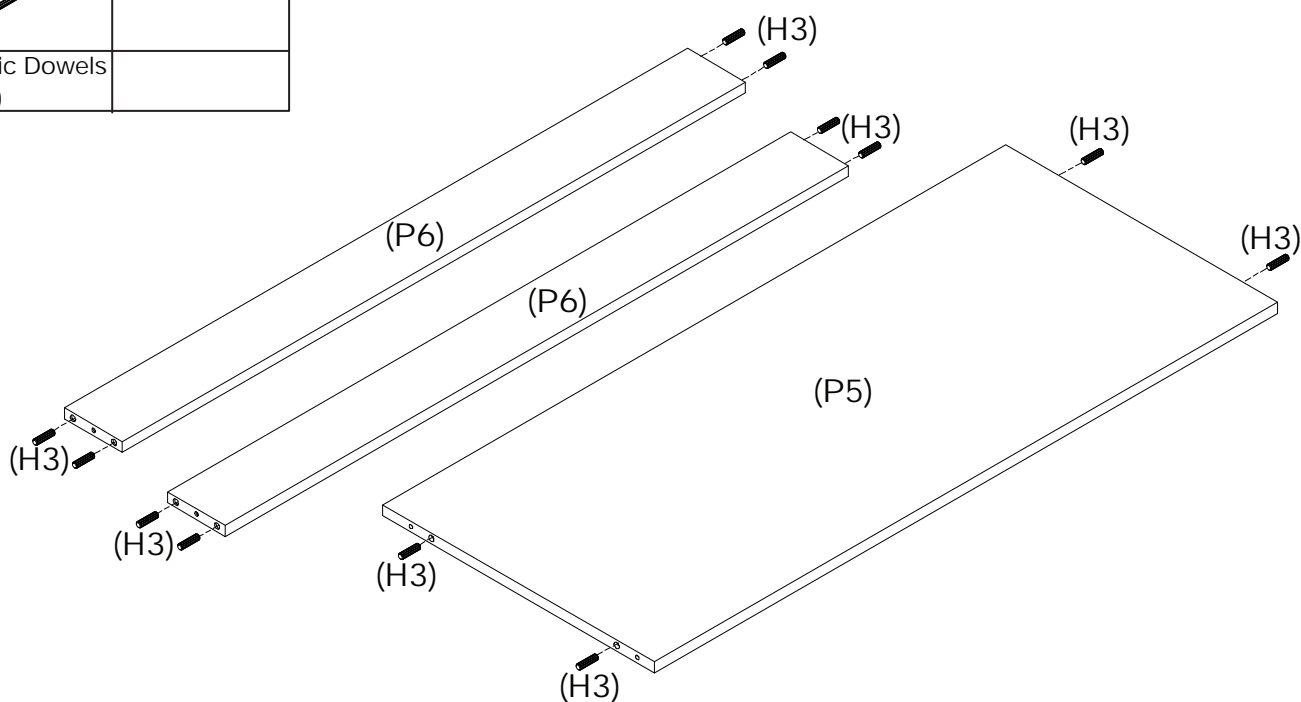
Fix 4 x Hinges (H4) to Door Panel (P10) using 8 x Screws (H5) by tightening with the Phillips Head Screwdriver.

Fix Metal Handle (H6) to pre-drilled holes using 2 x Screws (H7), tighten with a Phillips Head Screwdriver.

Repeat for 2nd Door Panel ( P10).




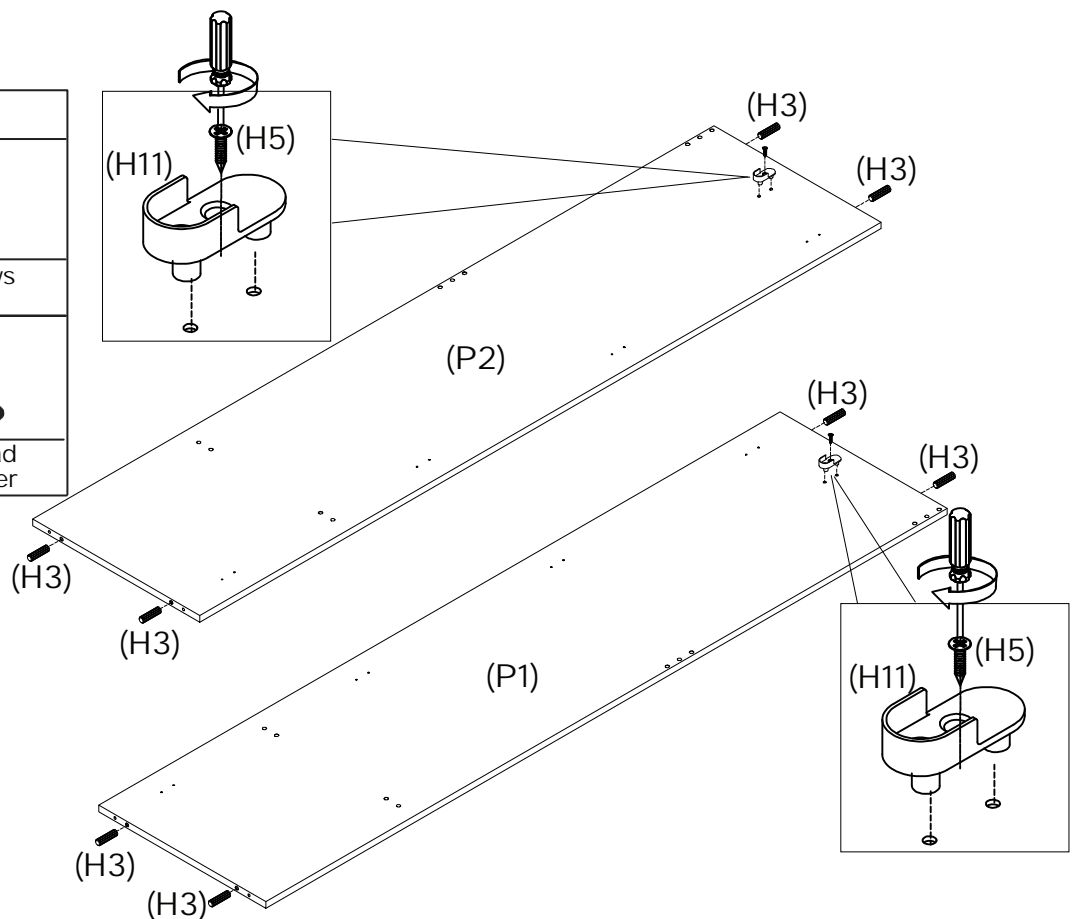

12X Plastic Dowels (H3)	



Insert 12 x Plastic Dowels (H3) to Panels (P6x2, P5) one by one.

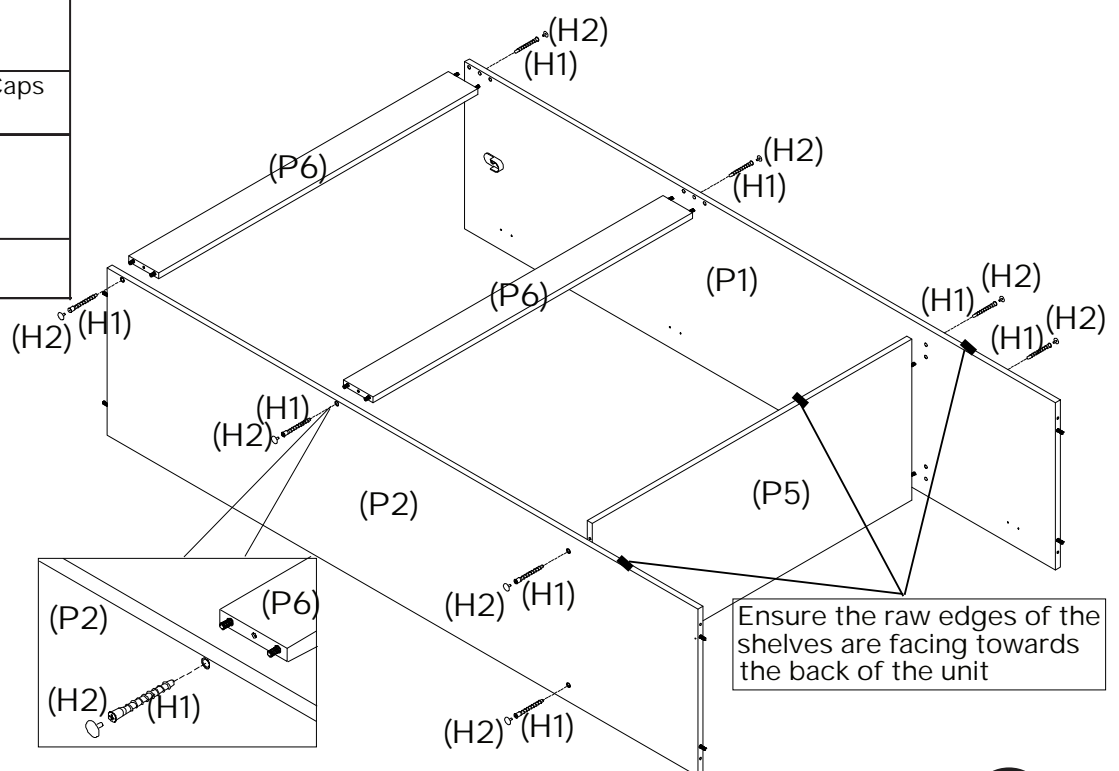

8X Plastic Dowels (H3)	2X Screws (H5)
	
2X Hanger Rod Holder (H11)	Phillips head Screwdriver



Fix 2 x Hanger Rod Holders (H11) to Side Panels (P1 & P2) as shown with 2 x Screw (H5) by tightening with the Phillips Head Screwdriver.  
Insert 8 x Plastic Dowels (H3) to Side Panels (P1&P2) one by one.



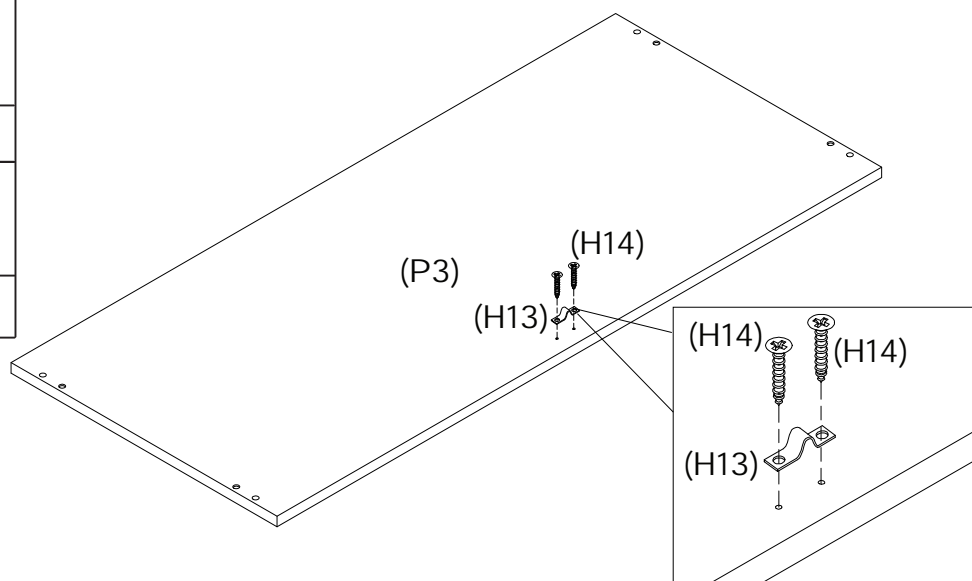

8X Screws (H1)	8X Plastic Caps (H2)
	
Phillips head Screwdriver	



Fix Back Support Panels (P6x2) to Side Panel (P1) with 8 x Screws (H1),  
Use Plastic Caps (H2) to cover the screws (H1).  
Repeat for Side Panel (P2).  
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## Step 5

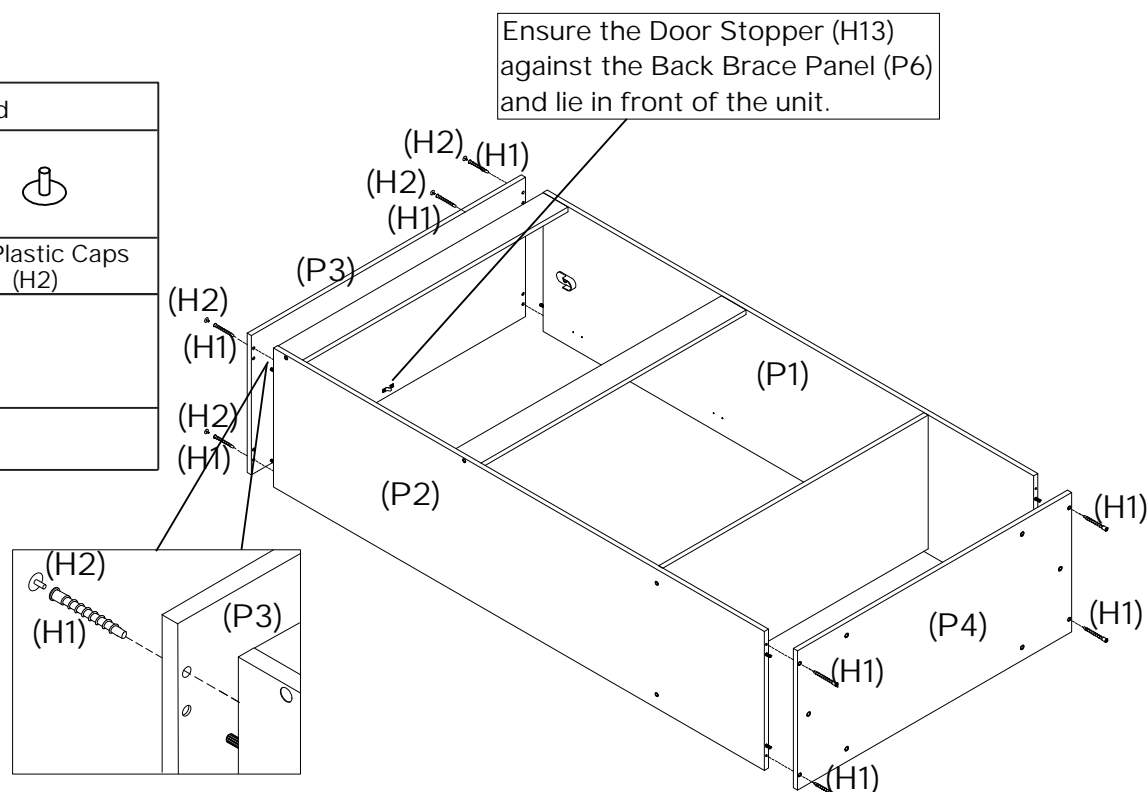
You will need	
	
1X Door Stopper (H13)	2X Screw (H14)
	
Phillips head Screwdriver	



Attach Door Stop (H13) to Top Panel (P3) with 2 x Screws (H14) as shown by tightening with the Phillips Head Screwdriver.

## Step 6

You will need	
	
8X Screws (H1)	4X Plastic Caps (H2)
	
Phillips head Screwdriver	



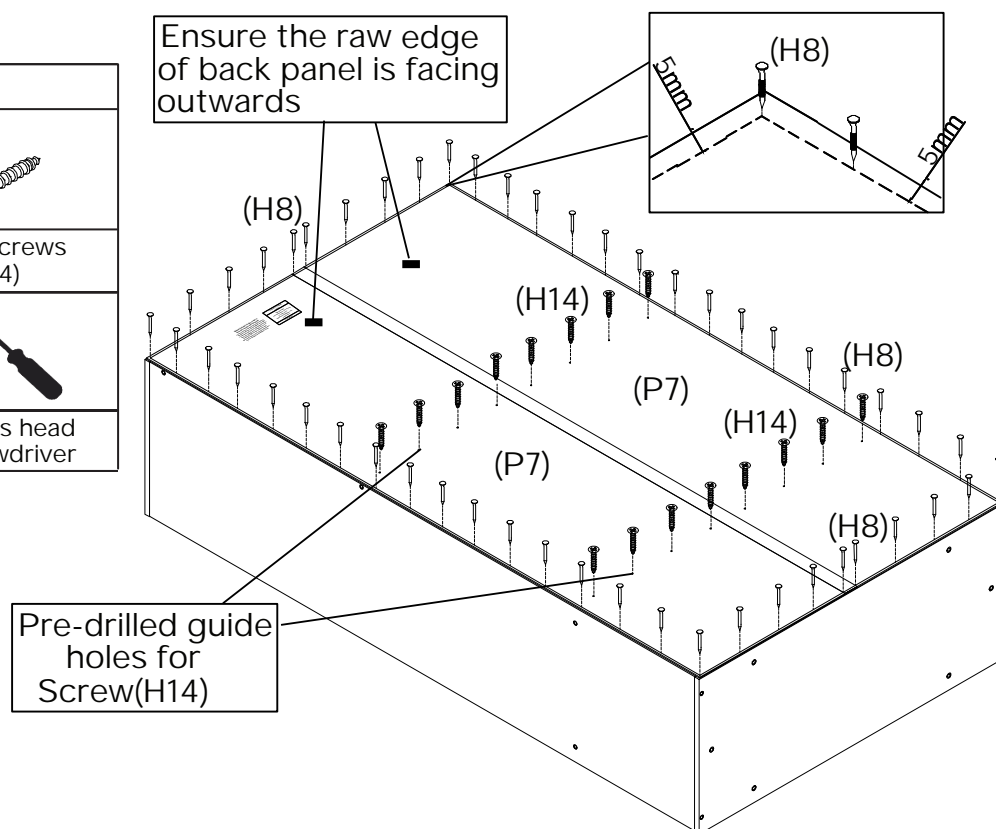
Fix Top and Bottom Panel (P3 & P4) to Side Panels (P1 & P2) with 8 x Screws (H1) by tightening with the Phillips Head Screwdriver.

Place 4 x Plastic Caps (H2) on top of the 4 x Screws (H1) in Top Panel (P3) as shown.  
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## Step 7

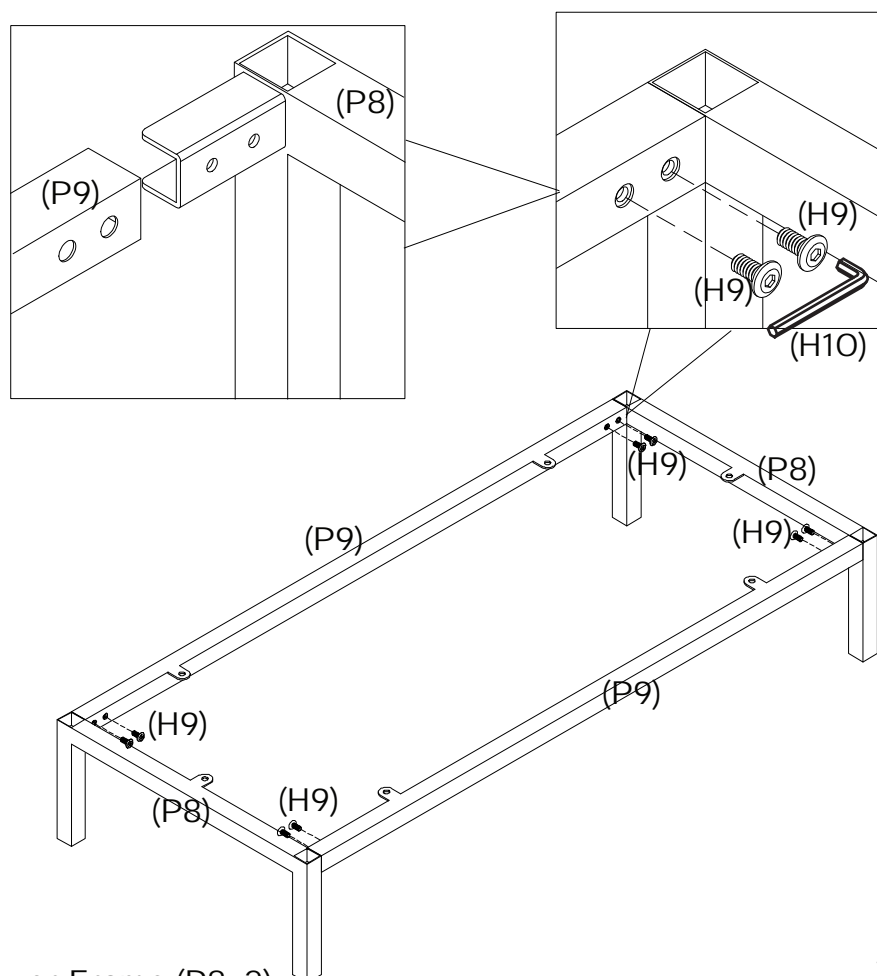
You will need	
	
50X Nails (H8)	16X Screws (H14)
	
Hammer	Phillips head Screwdriver



Using a Hammer, fix Back Panel (P7) to assembled unit using 50 x Nails (H8). Fix Back Panel (P7) to Fixed Shelves (P5) and Back Support Panel (P6) with 16 x Screws (H14), tighten Screws with a Phillips Head Screwdriver.



## Step 8

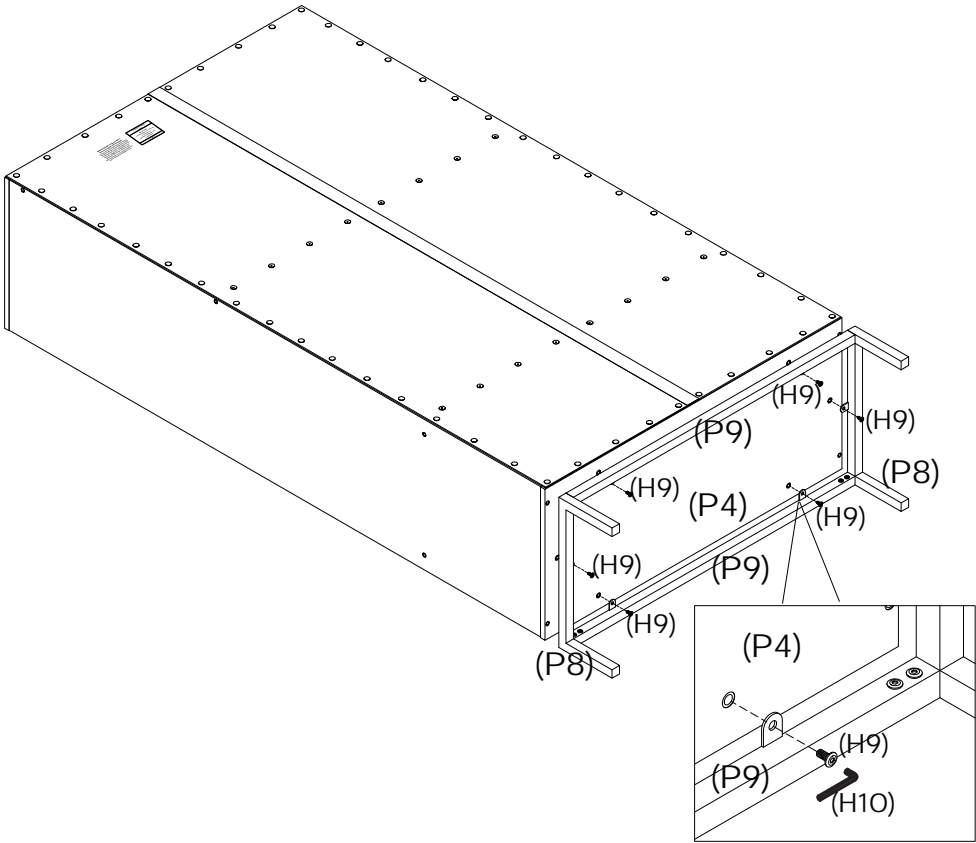

8X Screws (H9)	1X Allen Key (H10)



Attach Base Rails (P9x2) with Lower Frame (P8x2) as shown with 8 x Screws (H9) by tightening with Allen Key (H10).

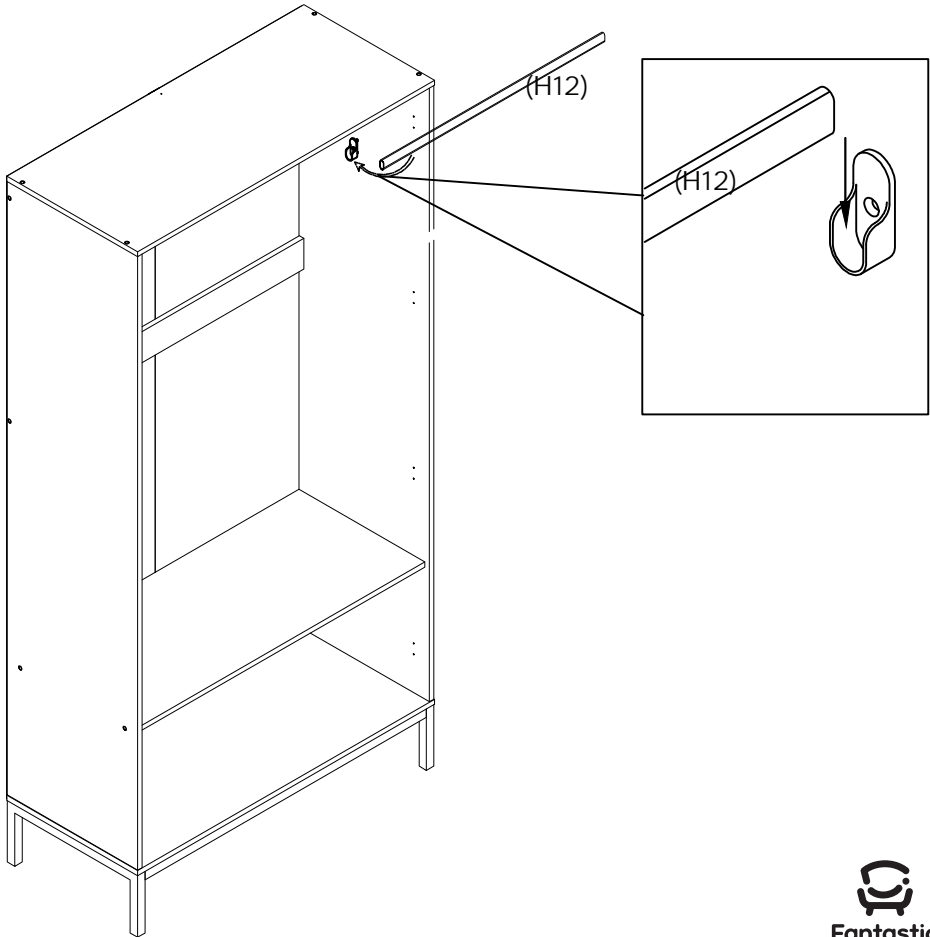

6X Screws (H9)	1X Allen Key (H10)



Fix assembled base frame to assembled unit using 6 x Screws (H9) ,by tightening with Allen Key (H10).



# Step 10

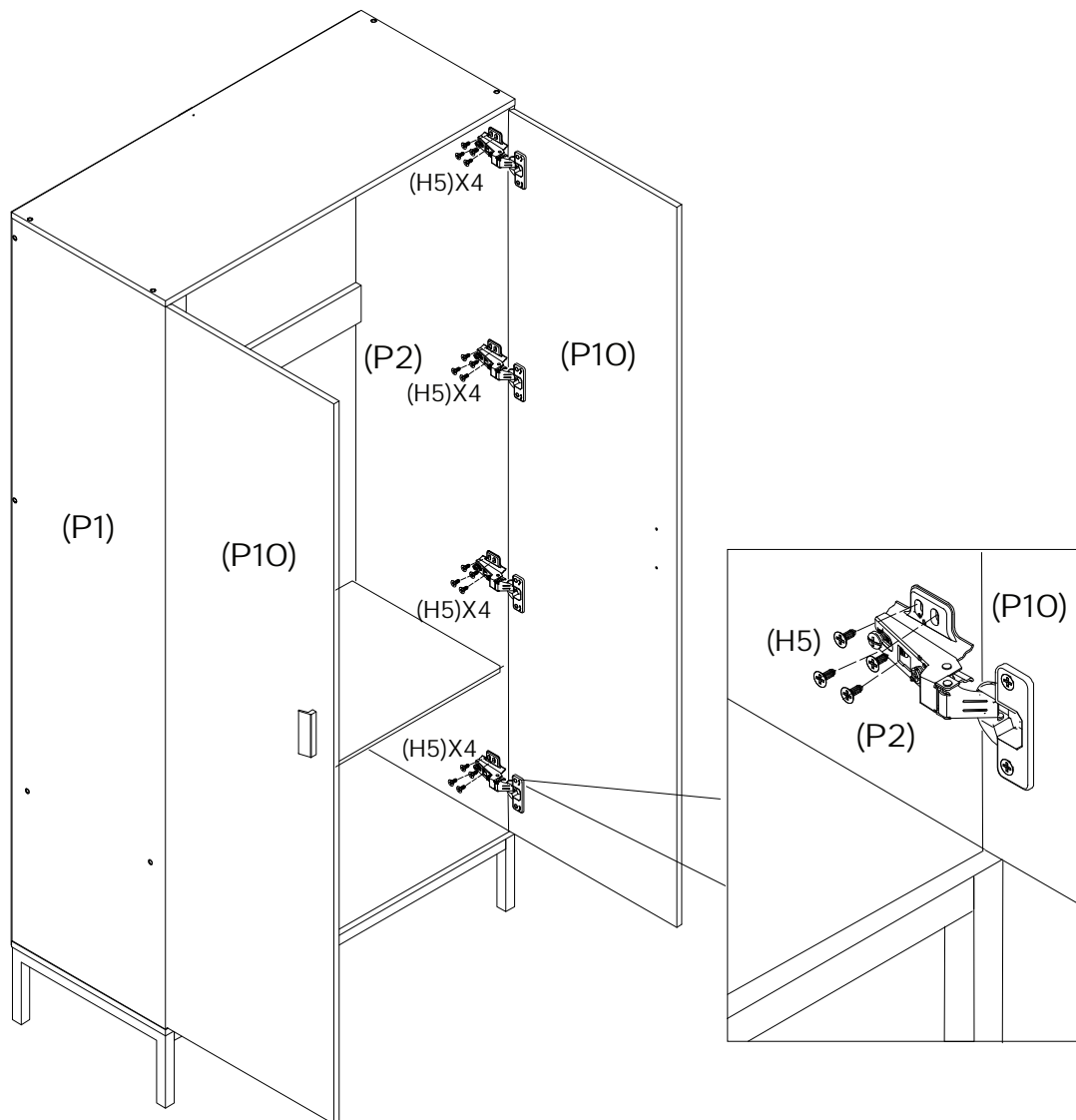

1X Hanger Rod (H12)	



Place Hanger Rod (H12) into Hanger Rod Holder (H11).

# Step 11

32X Screws (H5)	Phillips head Screwdriver




Fix Door Panels (P10x2) to Side Panels (P1,P2) using 32 x Screws (H5) by tightening with the Phillips Head Screwdriver.

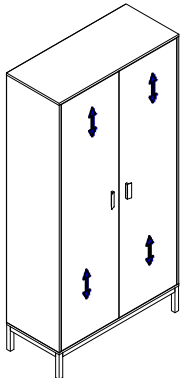
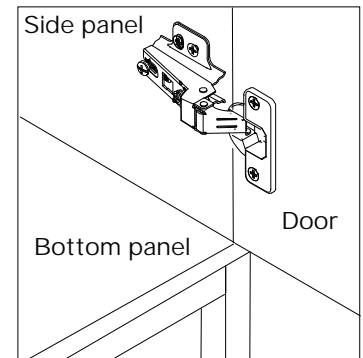

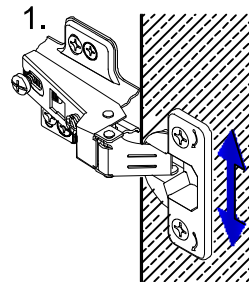
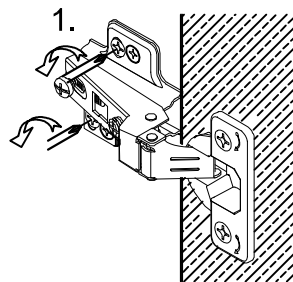
TO ADJUST YOU DOORS TO MAKE THE GAPS MORE EVEN (OPTIONAL)

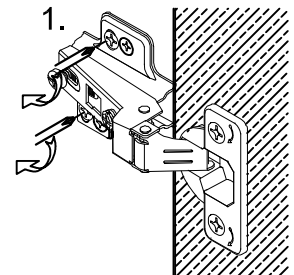
STEP 12.1  
Open the door.



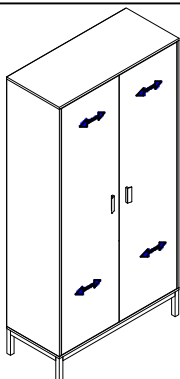
STEP 12.2

upward or downward



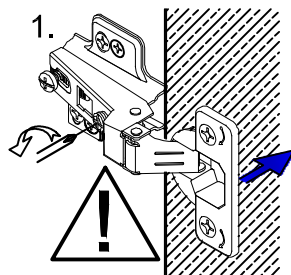
MOVE DOOR UPWARD  
OR DOWNWARD



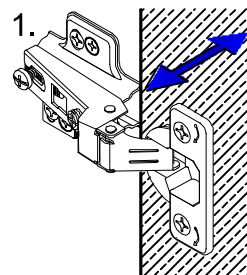
Tighten 2 screws in

round holes.



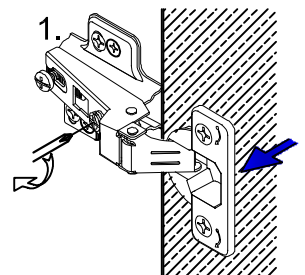
STEP 12.3

door panel and side panel



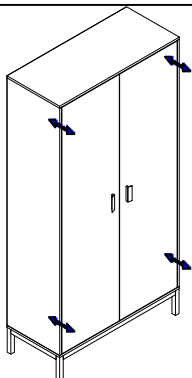
MOVE DOOR OUTWARD

counter-clockwise



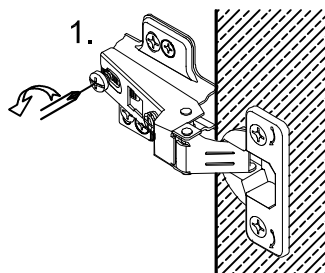
KEEP DOOR IN  
RIGHT POSITION



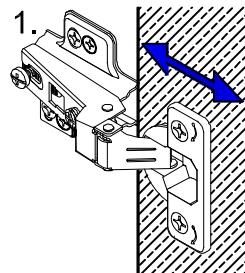
MOVE DOOR

screw clockwise



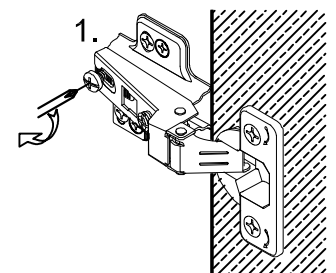
STEP 12.4

Loosen this screw a bit







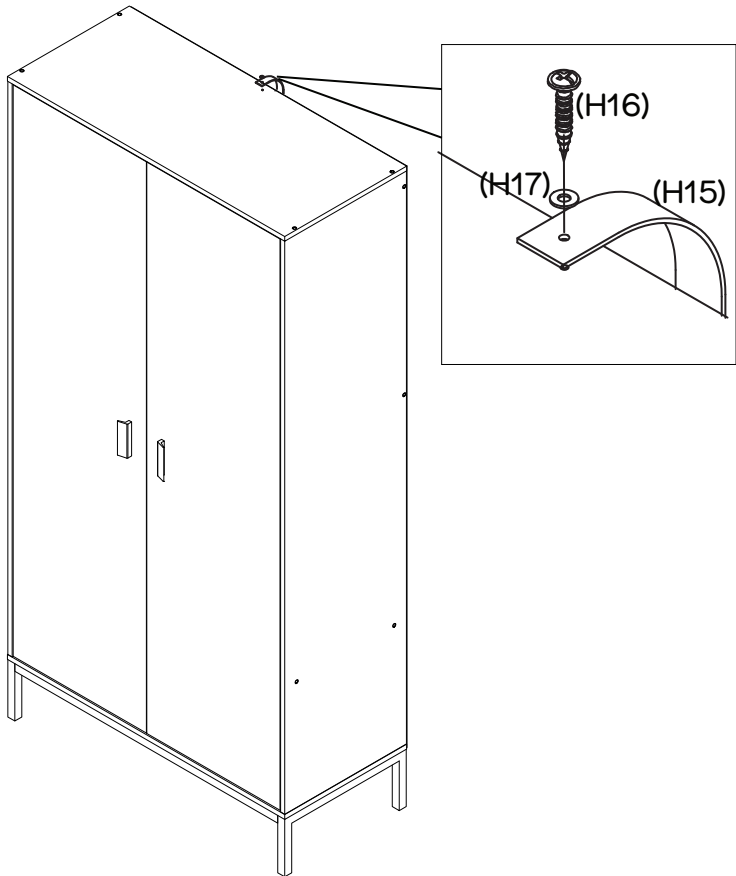
MOVE DOOR

# Step 13

You will need	
	
1 x Wall Strap (H15)	1 x Wall Strap Screw (H16)
	
1 x Washer (H17)	Phillips head Screwdriver

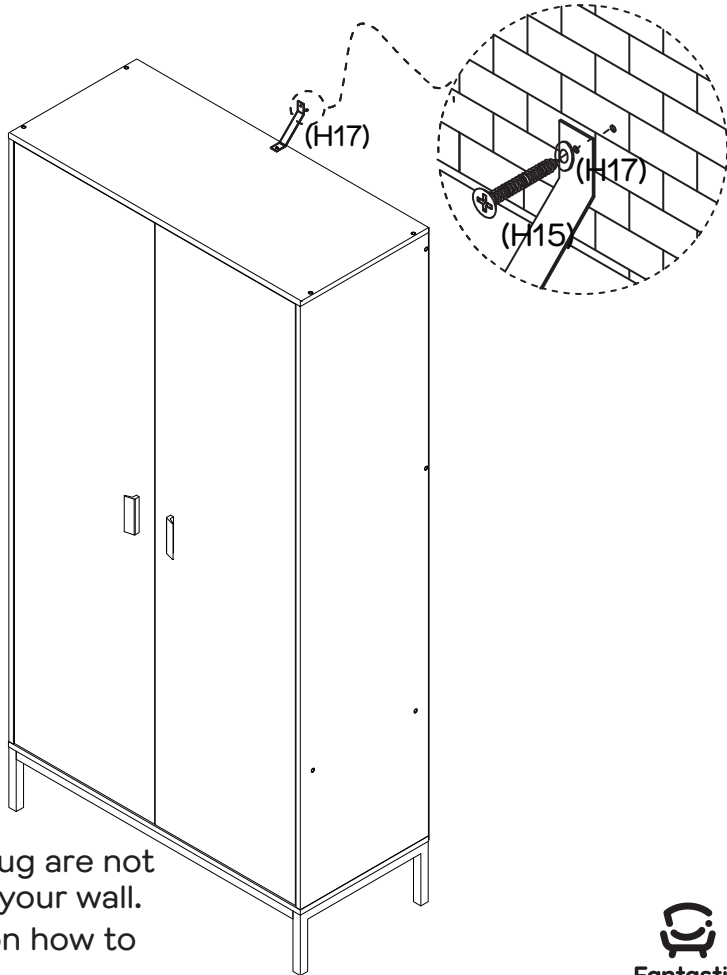


Attach the Wall Strap (H15) to Top Panel (P3) with 1 x Washer (H17) and 1 x Wall Strap Screw (H16) by tightening with the Phillips Head Screwdriver.



1 x Washer (H17)	

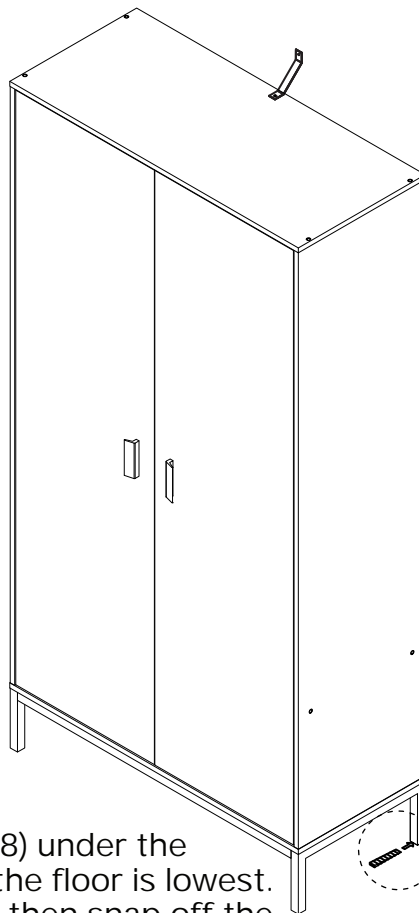
Screws and wall plugs are not provided please use appropriate fixtures for your wall.



Move the unit into it's final position and then secure the Safety Strap to the wall. Ensure it is firmly attached. Screw and wall plug are not provided. Please use appropriate fixtures for your wall.

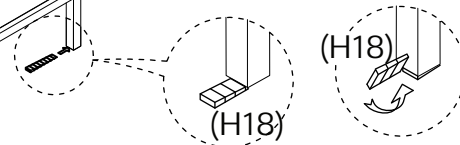
## Step 15

You will need

1 x Levelling Wedge (H18)

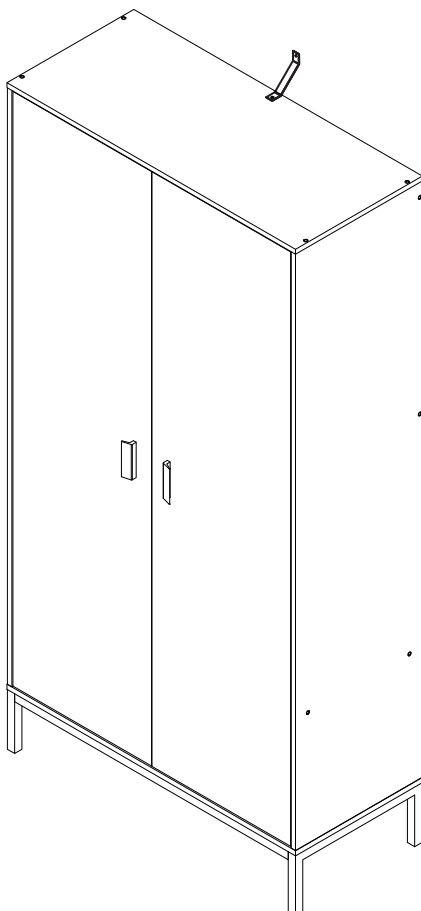


OPTIONAL STEP TO  
LEVEL WARDROBE ON  
UNEVEN FLOOR

Insert the levelling wedge (H18) under the wardrobe at the point where the floor is lowest. Push in until wardrobe is level, then snap off the excess wedge sections.
