

To avoid any serious or fatal injury, a wall strap has been provided with this product to prevent toppling. We strongly recommend that this product is permanently fixed to the wall or other suitable surface. Fixing devices are not included since different surface materials require different attachments. Please seek professional advice if you are in doubt of what fixing device to use.

To reduce the risk of furniture tipover:




- Do not allow children to stand, climb or hang on furniture. It may topple and cause serious injury or death.
- Do not place toys or other child appealing items on top of this furniture, and place heaviest items towards the bottom of the furniture.




- Do not open more than one drawer at the time.
- Anchoring this product to a wall or other suitable surface is recommended.
 Check anchors regularly.
- Avoid putting a TV on this product.

Wall attachment guide



For plasterboard (without available wood stud)

Securing method:Self drilling plasterboard anchor.



For plasterboard (with available wood stud)

Securing method:
Screw inserted directly into stud.



For masonry wall

Securing method: Solid wall: Plug with screw Hollow wall: Spring toggle

Rattan

Rattan is a natural material that will respond to humidity in the environment. Low humidity may cause the rattan to shrink. High humidity may cause the rattan to absorb moisture and expand, causing the weaving to look loose and wavy.

This is a natural phenomenon and not a defect.

Assembly Checklist



Read through the instructions carefully before you begin.



Make sure you have all the required tools. Never use power tools unless instructed.



Identify and lay out all of the components before you begin assembly.



Unless instructed, do not fully tighten screws until the item is fully assembled.

Useful Information


- ! Never use power tools unless specifically instructed. They can damage your components or hardware if used incorrectly.
- ! The most common mistakes made during assembly are using the wrong hardware or getting components back to front.
- ! Always use a soft surface (such as carpet or cardboard) when assembling your product to avoid scratching or damaging the surface of the product.
- ! Bulky items such as wardrobes and bunk beds should be assembled in the room they will be used in as they may not fit through a door once assembled.
- ! Never use any glue until you are certain that the parts belong together.
- ! Periodically check and re-tighten all fasteners. Check the product care label or website for product care instructions.







- 1 x Top Panel (P1)
- 1 x Left Side Panel (P2)
- 1 x Right Side Panel (P3)
- 1 x Left Divider Panel (P4)
- 1 x Right Divider Panel (P5)
- 2 x Fixed Shelves (P6)
- 1 x Adjustable Shelf (P7)
- 1 x Back Panel (P8)
- 1 x Bottom Panel (P9)
- 4 x Legs (P10)











Attach $4 \times \text{Felt Pads}$ (H5) to the bottom of legs (P10x4) by removing the adhesive backing and pressing firmly.




Attach Legs (P10x4) to Bottom Panel (P9) with $8 \times Bolts$ (H4), $8 \times Spring$ Washers (H7) and $8 \times Flat$ Washers (H6) as shown by tightening with the Allen Key (H12).





Insert 16 x Dowels (H3) into Left & Right Divider Panels (P4&P5) and Fixed Shelves (P6x2) as shown. Attach 4 x Cam Bolts (H1) to Left & Right Divider Panels (P4&P5) as shown by tightening with the Phillips Head Screwdriver.



to Left & Right Side Panels (P2&P3) as shown by tightening with the Phillips Head Screwdriver.








Insert 4 x Cam Nuts (H2) into Fixed Shelf (P6) as shown. Rotate the cam nuts so the arrows point towards the incoming cam bolts. Attach Left Side Panel (P2) and Left Divider Panel (P4) to Fixed Shelf (P6) by tightening the cam nuts with the Phillips Head Screwdriver.


Step 6




Insert 4 x Cam Nuts (H2) into
Fixed Shelf (P6) as shown.
Rotate the cam nuts
so the arrows point towards
the incoming cam bolts.


Attach Right Side Panel (P3)
and Right Divider Panel (P5)
to Fixed Shelf (P6) by tightening
the cam nuts with the Phillips Head Screwdriver.


Ensure the raw edges on the shelf and divider panel are at the back of the bookcase before securing.






Attach Left & Right Side Panels (P2&P3) and Left & Right Divider Panels (P4&P5) to Bottom Panel (P9) as shown with 8 x Screws (H9) by tightening with the Phillips Head Screwdriver.






Attach 8 x Cam Bolts (H1) to Top Panel (P1) by tightening with the Phillips Head Screwdriver.

Step 10





Insert 8 x Cam Nuts (H2) into Left & Right Side Panels (P2&P3) and Left & Right Divider Panels (P4&P5) as shown. Rotate the cam nuts so the arrows point towards the incoming cam bolts. Attach Top Panel (P1) to Left & Right Side Panels (P2&P3) and Left & Right Divider Panels (P4&P5) by tightening the cam nuts with the Phillips Head Screwdriver.






Insert 4 x Back Panel Connectors (H10) into the corners of the assembled bookcase as shown and secure with 4 x Back Panel Screws (H11) by tightening with the Phillips Head Screwdriver.










Insert 4 x Shelf Pins (H8) into Left & Right Divider Panels (P4&P5) at your desired height. Place Adjustable Shelf (P7) into bookcase as shown by resting on the shelf pins. Ensure the shelf is firmly secured in place before using.


Step 14





Attach Wall Straps (H14) to back of Top Panel (P1) with $2 \times \text{Flat}$ Washers (H6) and $2 \times \text{Wall}$ Strap Screws (H13) by tightening with the Phillips Head Screwdriver.
