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




Insert 2 x side rails (P4) into the corresponding holes in the back frame (P1) as shown. Secure together using 2×1 , tightening using the allen key (H4). Do not fully tighten screws. Leave them a little loose at this stage.




Attach the assembled seat frame (P1,P3,P5) to the back frame (P1) and side rails (P4) as shown. Secure together using 5×1 bolts (H1) and 5×1 washers (H3). Do not fully tighten bolts. Leave them a little loose at this stage.



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


