

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
Assembly Checklist



Read through the instructions carefully before you begin.



Make sure you have all the required tools. Never use power tools unless instructed.



Identify and lay out all of the components before you begin assembly.



Unless instructed, do not fully tighten screws until the item is fully assembled.

Useful Information

- ! Never use power tools unless specifically instructed. They can damage your components or hardware if used incorrectly.
- ! The most common mistakes made during assembly are using the wrong hardware or getting components back to front.
- ! Always use a soft surface (such as carpet or cardboard) when assembling your product to avoid scratching or damaging the surface of the product.
- ! Bulky items such as wardrobes and bunk beds should be assembled in the room they will be used in as they may not fit through a door once assembled.
- ! Never use any glue until you are certain that the parts belong together.
- ! Periodically check and re-tighten all fasteners. Check the product care label or website for product care instructions.

Step 1 You will need H6 H2 H2 4 x Dowels 8 x Long Bolts (H1) (H2) (P3) (P2) 1 x Allen key H2 (H6) H2 (P2) (P3) H2 H2


Insert 4 x Dowels (H1) into Rails (P2 x 2) as shown. Attach Rails (P3 x 2) to Rails (P2 x 2) with 8 x Long Bolts (H2) by tightening with the Allen Key (H6).



Attach 14 x Cam Bolts (H3) to Top Panel (P1) as shown, tightening with the Phillips Head Screwdriver.

Step 3 You will need (P2) H4 H4 (P3) H4 14 x Cam Nuts Phillips Head **H**4 Screwdriver (H4) **4** H4[@] , **№** H4 **҈**₩ H4 "H4 H4® (P3) **H4** (P2) (P1) This is how a cam nut works...... The head of the cam bolt goes into the open mouth of the cam nut. You then turn the cam nut so it tightens over the


Insert 14 x Cam Nuts (H4) into Rails (P2 x 2 & P3 x 2). Rotate the nuts so the arrows point towards the incoming bolts. Attach Rails (P2 x 2 & P3 x 2) to Top Panel (P1), then tighten the cam nuts with a Phillips Head Screwdriver.




Attach 12 x Cam Bolts (H3) to Legs (P4 x2 & P6 x 2) as shown, tightening with the Phillips Head Screwdriver.



Step 5




Insert 4 x Dowels (H1) into Legs (P4 & P6). Insert 6 x Cam Nuts (H4) into Legs (P5 & P7). Rotate the nuts so the arrows point towards the incoming bolts. Attach Leg (P4) to Leg (P5), Leg (P6) to Leg (P7), then tighten the cam nuts with a Phillips Head Screwdriver. Repeat this Step for other legs (P4 & P5 & P6 & P7).




Secure the Legs (P4 x 2 & P5 x 2 & P6 x 2 & P7 x 2) to the Rails (P2 x 2 & P3 x 2) using 16 x Bolts (H5), 16 x Washers (H9) and 16 x Spring Washers (H10), tightening with the Allen Key (H6).






Secure 8 x Plastic Glides (H7) to Legs (P4 x 2 & P5 x 2 & P6 x 2 & P7 x 2) as shown by gently tapping with a hammer.

Step 8






Cover the cam nut holes on Legs (P5 \times 2 & P7 \times 2) using 8 \times Stickers (H8).



Step 9 H2 You will need H6 8 x Dowels 16 x Long Bolts (H1) (H2) (P9) (P3) H2 1 x Allen key (H6) H2 (P3) x2


Insert 4 x Dowels (H1) into Rails (P9 x 2) as shown. Attach Rails (P3 x 2) to Rails (P9 x 2) with 8 x Long Bolts (H2) by tightening with the Allen Key (H6). Repeat this Step for other Rails (P9 x 2 & P3 x 2).




Attach 10 x Cam Bolts (H3) to Top Panel (P8) as shown, tightening with the Phillips Head Screwdriver.

Repeat this Step for another Top Panel (P8).




Insert 10 x Cam Nuts (H4) into Rails (P9 x 2 & P3 x 2). Rotate the nuts so the arrows point towards the incoming bolts. Attach Rails (P9 x 2 & P3 x 2) to Top Panel (P8), then tighten the cam nuts with a Phillips Head Screwdriver. Repeat this Step for another Top Panel (P8) and other Rails (P9 x 2 & P3 x 2) .




Attach 4 x Cam Bolts (H3) to Legs (P10 & P12) as shown, tightening with the Phillips Head Screwdriver. Repeat this Step for other Legs (P10 x 3 & P12 x 3).


Step 13




Insert 2 x Dowels (H1) into Legs (P10 & P12). Insert $4 \times Cam$ Nuts (H4) into Legs (P11 & P13). Rotate the nuts so the arrows point towards the incoming bolts. Attach Leg (P10) to Leg (P11), Leg (P12) to Leg (P13), then tighten the cam nuts with a Phillips Head Screwdriver. Repeat this Step for other Legs (P12 \times 3 & P13 \times 3 & P10 \times 3 & P11 \times 3).



Secure the Legs (P10 x 2 & P11 x 2 & P12 x 2 & P13 x 2) to the Rails (P9 x 2 & P3 x 2) using 16 x Bolts (H5), 16 x Washers (H9) and 16 x Spring Washers (H10), tightening with the Allen Key (H6). Repeat this Step for another Bench.




Secure 8 x Plastic Glides (H7) to Legs (P10 x 2 & P11 x 2 & P12 x 2 & P13 x 2) as shown by gently tapping with a hammer. Repeat this Step for another Bench .



Cover the cam nut holes on Legs (P11 \times 2 & P13 \times 2) using 4 \times Stickers (H8). Repeat this Step for another Bench.
