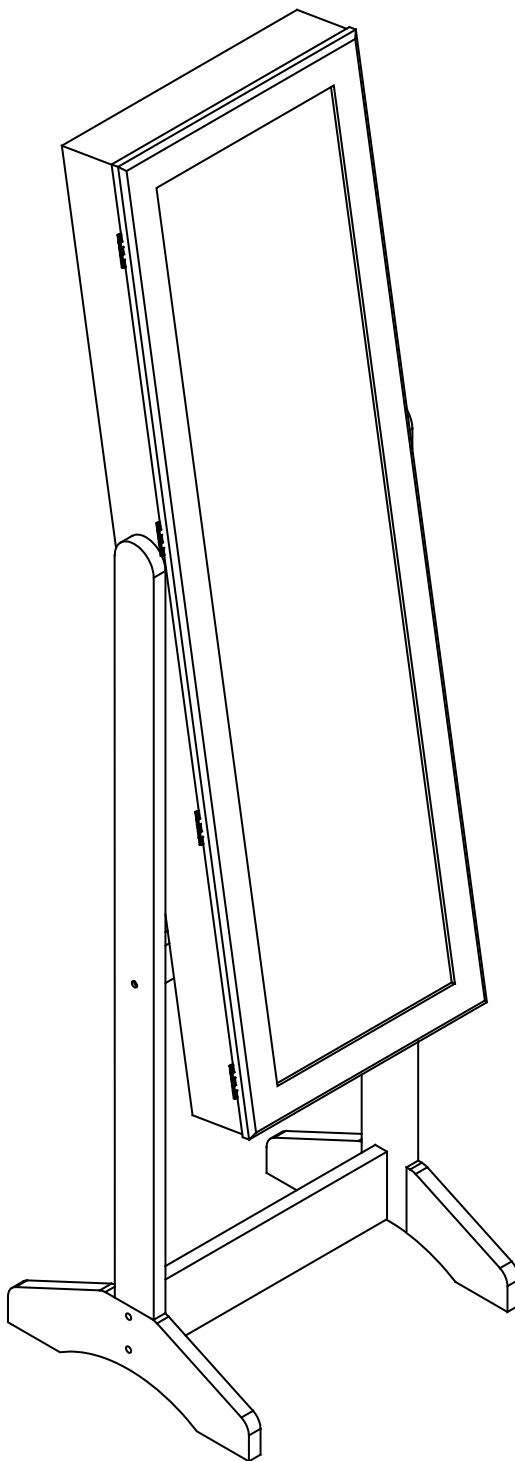

To reduce the risk of furniture tipover:

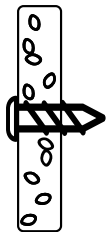


- Do not allow children to stand, climb or hang on furniture. It may topple and cause serious injury or death.



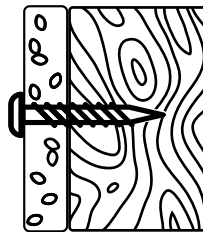
- Do not place toys or other child appealing items on top of this furniture, and place heaviest items towards the bottom of the furniture.

Wall attachment guide



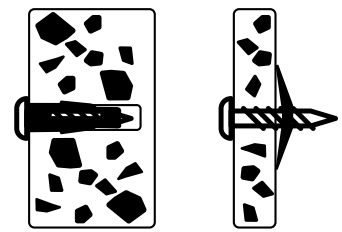
For plasterboard

(with available wood stud)

Securing method:
Screw inserted directly into stud.



For masonry wall

Securing method:
Solid wall: Plug with screw
Hollow wall: Spring toggle

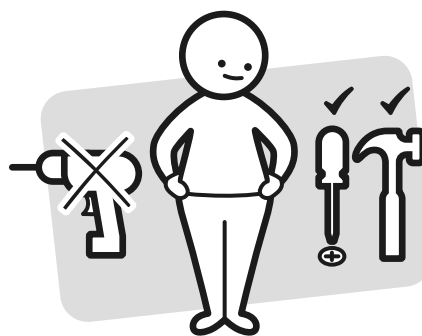

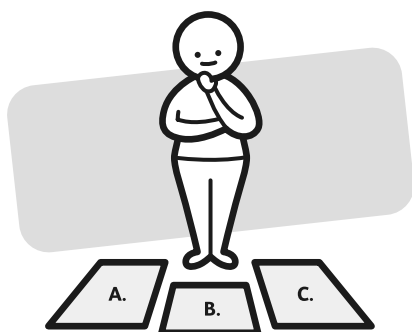
Assembly Checklist



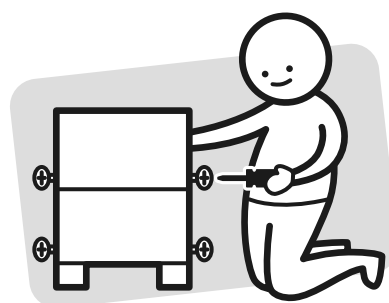
Read through the instructions carefully before you begin.



Make sure you have all the required tools. Never use power tools unless instructed.



Identify and lay out all of the components before you begin assembly.



Unless instructed, do not fully tighten screws until the item is fully assembled.

Useful Information

- ! Never use power tools unless specifically instructed. They can damage your components or hardware if used incorrectly.
- ! The most common mistakes made during assembly are using the wrong hardware or getting components back to front.
- ! Always use a soft surface (such as carpet or cardboard) when assembling your product to avoid scratching or damaging the surface of the product.
- ! Bulky items such as wardrobes and bunk beds should be assembled in the room they will be used in as they may not fit through a door once assembled.
- ! Never use any glue until you are certain that the parts belong together.
- ! Periodically check and re-tighten all fasteners. Check the product care label or website for product care instructions.
- ! If you are having any difficulties assembling your product, missing any hardware or components please visit our website Help Centre for further assistance.
- ! Please see page 2 for any safety requirements or weight restrictions.

Step 1

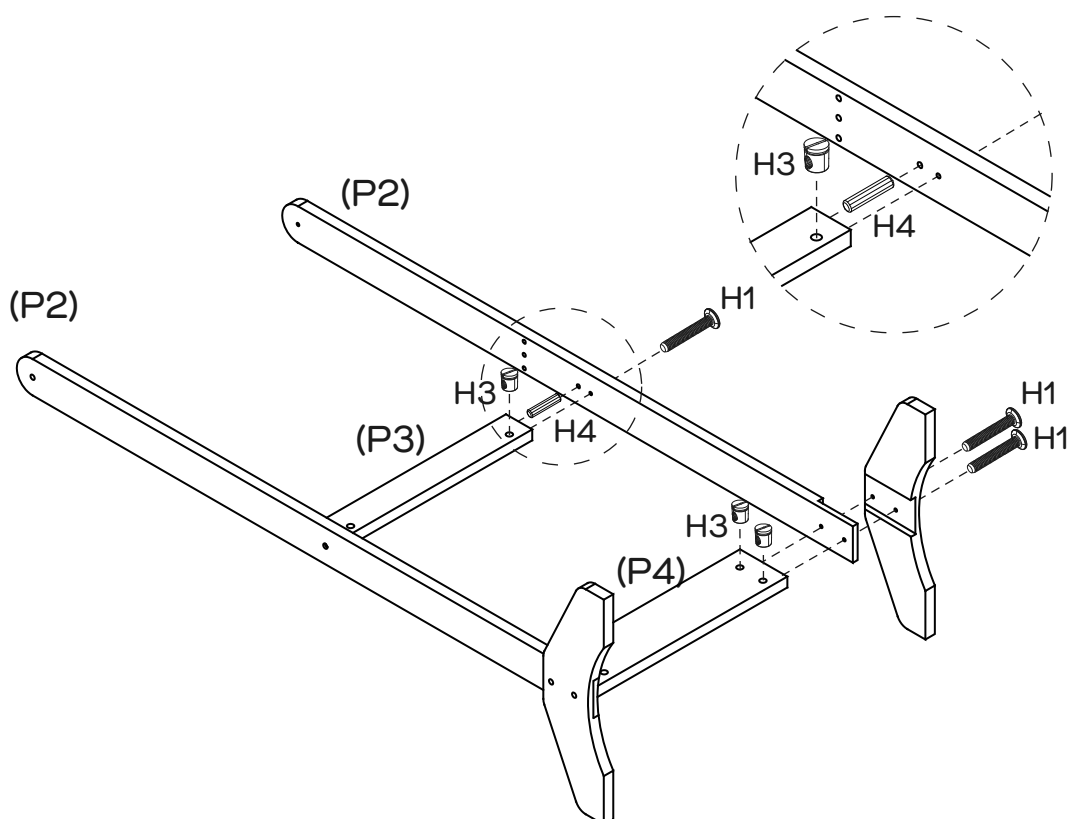
You will need	
	
3 x Bolts (H1)	3 x Barrels (H3)
	
1 x Dowel (H4)	Phillips head screwdriver
	
Flat head screwdriver	



Insert 1 x Dowel (H4) & 1 x Barrel (H3) into Support Rail (P3) and 2 x Barrels (H3) into Support Rail (P4). Ensure the Barrels (H3) are rotated horizontally with the Flat Head Screwdriver ready for the incoming Bolts. Use 3 x Bolts (H1) to attach Support Leg (P5) and Support Rails (P3&P4) to Frame (P2) as shown by tightening the Bolts with the Phillips Head Screwdriver.



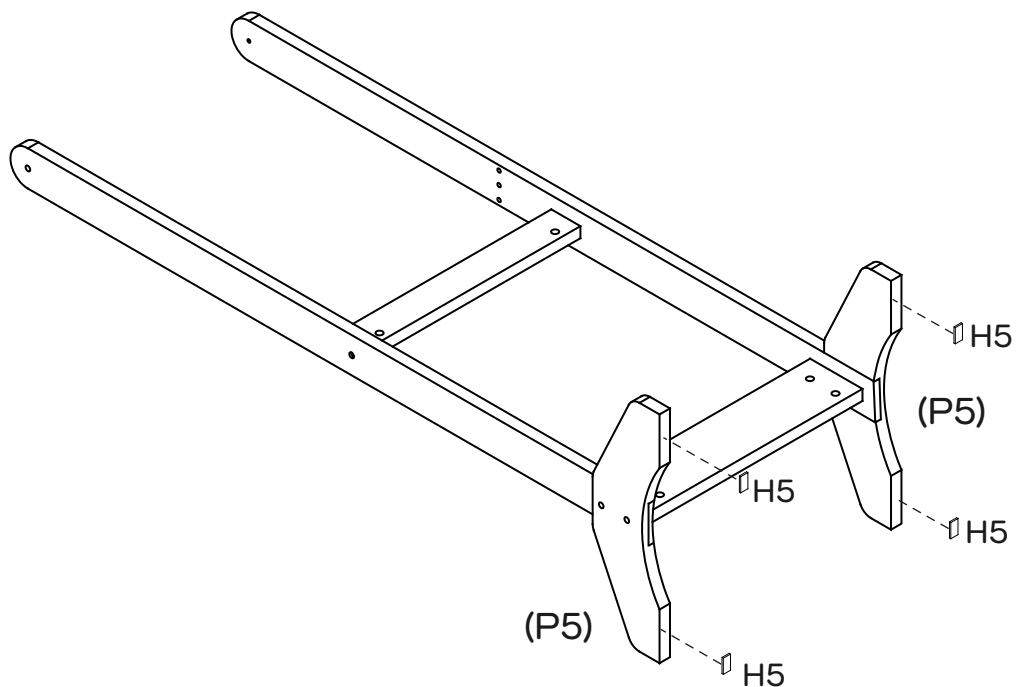
You will need	
	
3 x Bolts (H1)	3 x Barrels (H3)
	
1 x Dowel (H4)	Phillips head screwdriver
	
Flat head screwdriver	



Insert 1 x Dowel (H4) & 1 x Barrel (H3) into Support Rail (P3) and 2 x Barrels (H3) into Support Rail (P4). Ensure the Barrels (H3) are rotated horizontally with the Flat Head Screwdriver ready for the incoming Bolts. Use 3 x Bolts (H1) to attach Support Leg (P5) and Support Rails (P3&P4) to Frame (P2) as shown by tightening the Bolts with the Phillips Head Screwdriver.




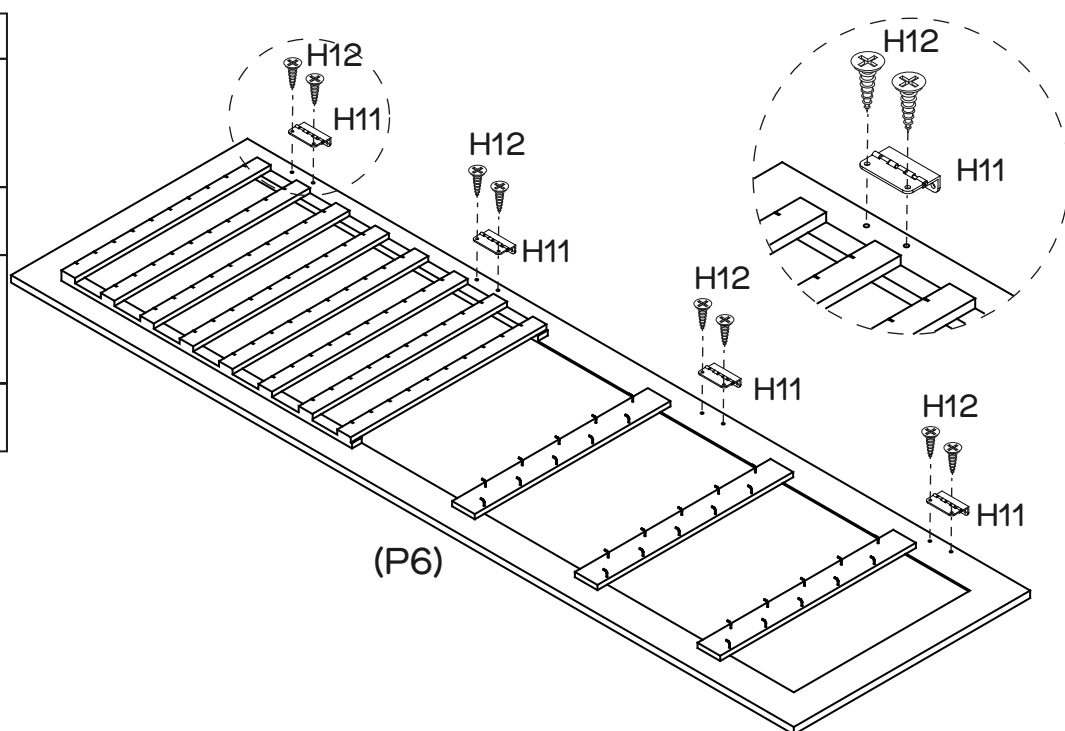

4 x Felt Pads (H5)	



Apply 4 x Felt pads (H5) to bottom of Legs (P5) as shown.



Step 4

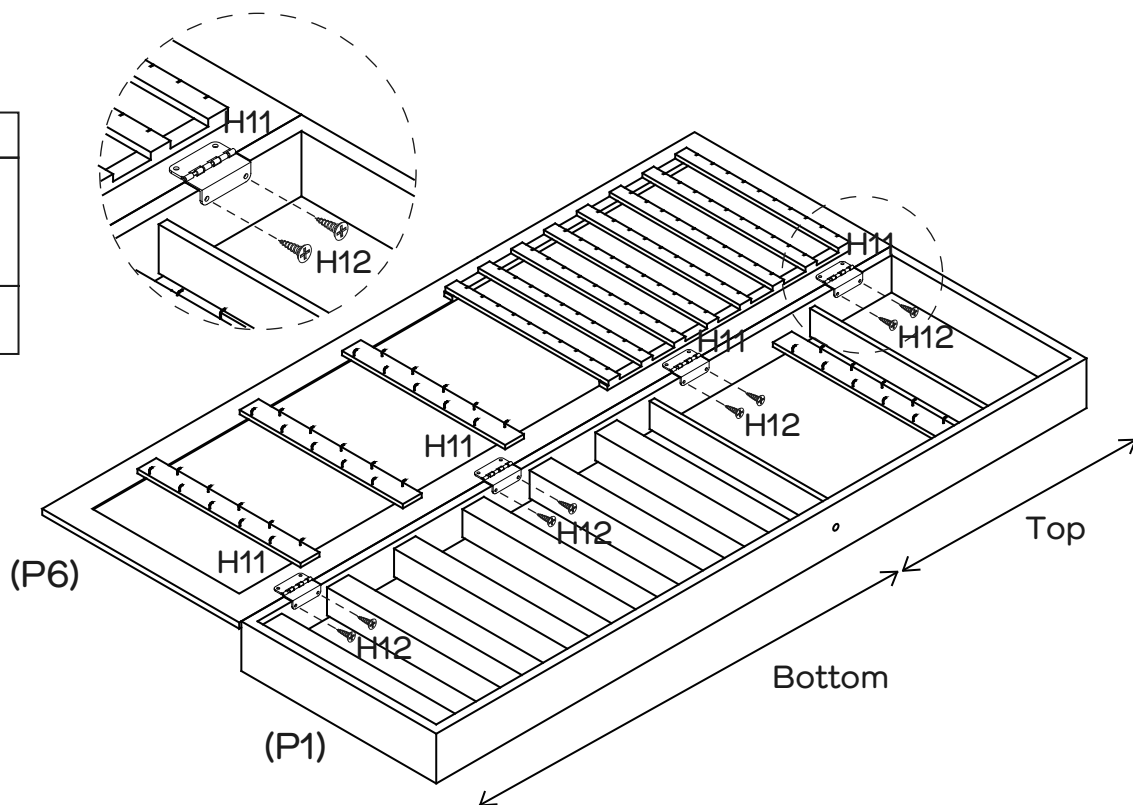

4 x Hinges (H11)	8 x Hinge Screws (H12)
	
Phillips head screwdriver	



Attach 4 x Hinges (H11) to Door panel (P6) and secure by tightening 8 x Hinge Screws (H12) with the Phillips Head Screwdriver.



Step 5

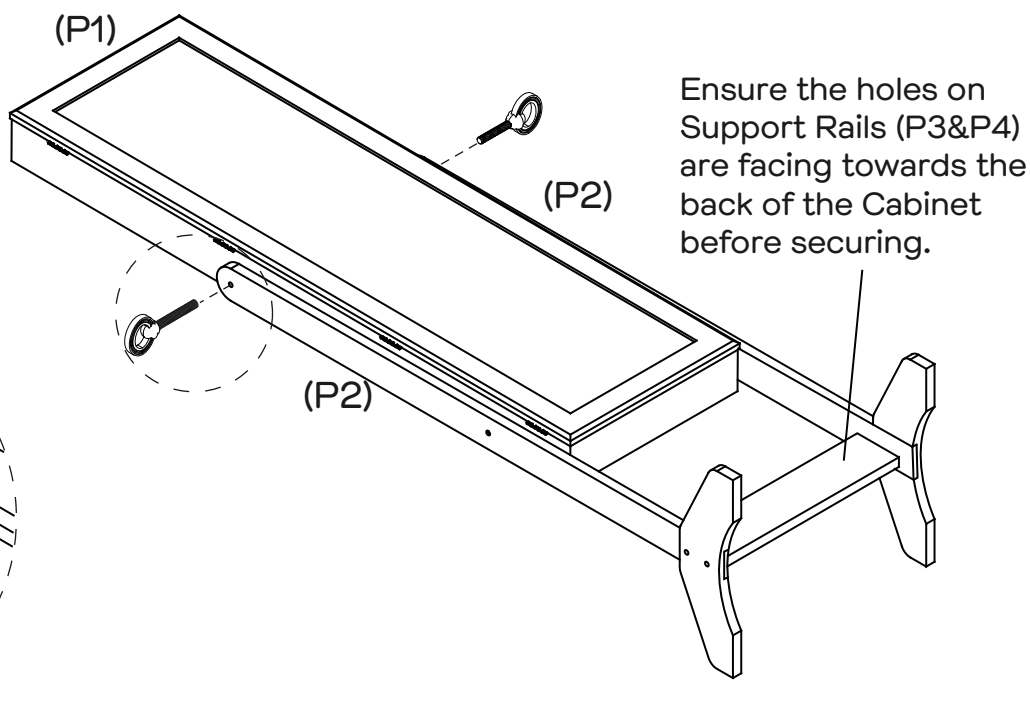

8 x Hinge Screws (H12)	Phillips head screwdriver



Secure Door panel (P6) to Cabinet (P1) by attaching reverse of 4 x Hinges (H11) with 8 x Hinge Screws (H12) by tightening with Phillips Head Screwdriver.






Step 6

You will need	
	
2 x Ring Bolts (H2)	2 x Plastic Washers (H10)



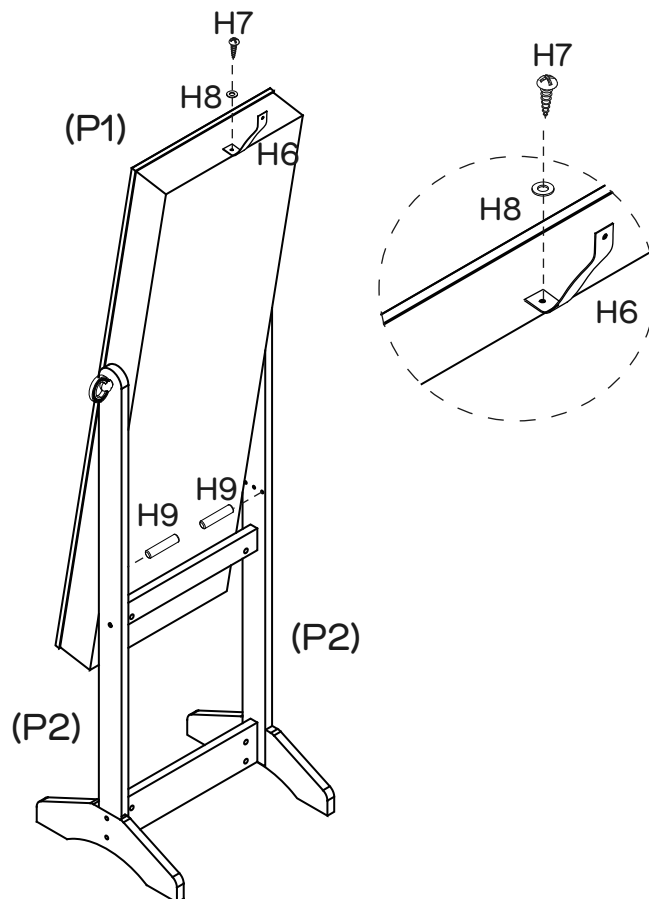
Thread the Ring Bolts (H2x2) and Plastic Washers (H10x2) through each side of the Frame (P2) and secure to the Cabinet (P1) by winding the Ring Bolts (H2x2) to tighten.

Step 7



You will need	
	
1 x Safety Strap (H6)	1 x Screw (H7)
	
1 x Washer (H8)	2 x Plastic Plugs (H9)
	
Phillips head screwdriver	

Insert 2 x Plastic Plugs (H9x2) into each side of the Frame (P2) and then gently rest the Cabinet (P1) against the Plastic Plugs (H9x2).

To connect 1 x Safety Strap (H6) to the top of the Cabinet (P1) use 1 x Washer (H8) and Screw (H7) by tightening with the Phillips Head Screwdriver. We strongly suggest you use the wall strap provided to prevent the unit from toppling.

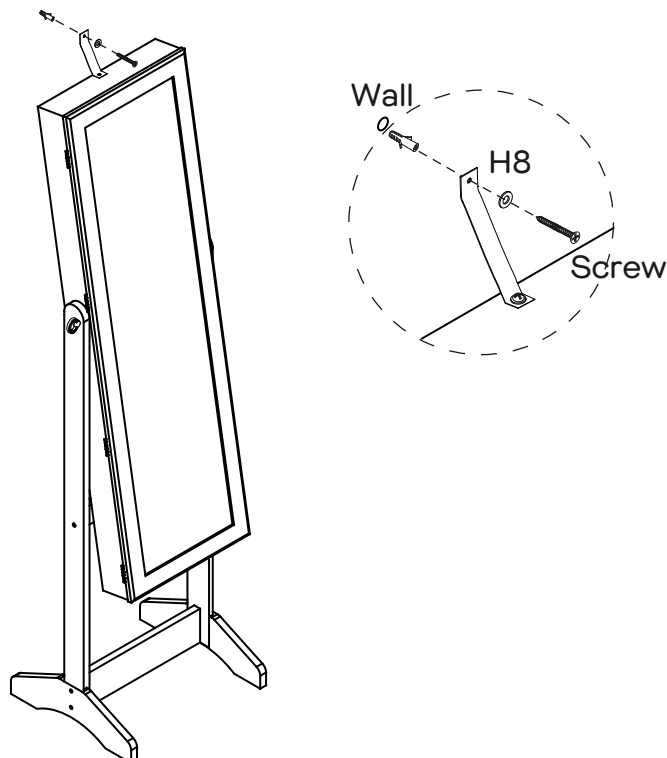


Step 8

You will need	
	
1 x Washer (H8)	Phillips head screwdriver
Screw and Wall Plug are not provided. Please use appropriate fixtures for your wall.	

Move the unit into it's final position and then secure the Safety Strap to the wall. Ensure it is firmly attached. Screw and wall plug are not provided. Please use appropriate fixtures for your wall.

* Seek advice from a qualified tradesperson on how to attach this safety strap to your specific wall.
