




Attach Top & Lower Left Frames (P5&P6) with 2 x Screws (H3) by tightening with the Allen Key (H5).



Secure 4 x Adjustable Feet (H1) to the bottom of Lower Left & Right Frames (P6&P10) as shown.




Attach Top & Lower Middle Frames (P11&P12) with 2×1 Screws (H3) by tightening with the Allen Key (H5). Secure 2×1 Adjustable Feet (H1) to the bottom of Lower Middle Frame (P12) as shown.






Attach Top & Lower Left Frames (P5&P6) and Top & Lower Middle Frames (P11&P12) to Large Top Panel (P1) and Large Shelf Panels (P2x2) with 12 x Screws (H3) as shown by tightening with the Allen Key (H5).

Secure Hanging Rails (P8x2) to Top & Lower Left Frames (P5&P6) and Top & Lower Middle Frames (P11&P12) with $4 \times \text{Screws}$ (H3) as shown by tightening with the Allen Key (H5).






Secure Back Supports (P7x2) together as shown with 1 x Nut (H4) and 1 x Screw (H2) by tightening with the Allen Key (H5) and Wrench (H9).

Repeat steps for the second set of Back Supports (P7x2).




Secure Back Panel (P13) to the back of the partially assembled drawer unit as shown with 20 x Nails, approximately 5mm from the edge, using the Hammer. Ensure the Back Panel is sitting square in the unit before securing, with about 2mm around each edge.







Secure the Drawer Front (P14) to Drawer Left & Right Side Panels (P15&P16) and Drawer Support Panel (P19) as shown by tightening 5 x Cam Nuts (H15) with the Phillips Head Screwdriver.
