

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Assembly checklist





Read through the instructions carefully before you begin.





Make sure you have all the required tools. Never use power tools unless instructed.





Identify and lay out all of the components Unless instructed, do not fully tighten screws until the item is fully assembled.

Useful Information


- ! Never use power tools unless specifically instructed. They can damage your components or hardware if used incorrectly.
- ¹ The most common mistakes made during assembly are using the wrong hardware or getting components back to front.
- ! Always use a soft surface (such as carpet or cardboard) when assembling your product to avoid scratching or damaging the surface of the product.
- ! Bulky items such as wardrobes and bunk bed should be assembled in the room they will be used in as they may not fit through a door once assembled.
- ! Never use any glue until you are certain that the parts belong together.
- ! Periodically check and re-tighten all fasteners. Check the product care label or website for product care instructions.

- ! Please see page 2 for any safety requirements or weight restrictions.













Attach 6 x large cam bolts (H1) to top panel (P1), tightening using a phillips head screwdriver.

Step 2




Insert 4 x wooden dowels (H3) into the front support rail (P5) and back support rail (P6) using a soft headed mallet.






Attach 3 x large cam bolts (H1) to left side (P2), tightening using a phillips head screwdriver. Insert 2 x wooden dowels (H3) into the left side (P2) using a soft headed mallet. Attach 2 x left runner tracks (H11) to left side (P2) using 6 x small screws (H9), tightening with a phillips head screwdriver. Ensure you insert the small screws (H9) into the holes on the tracks (H11) as shown.




Attach 3 x large cam bolts (H1) to right side (P3), tightening using a phillips head screwdriver.

Insert 2 x wooden dowels (H3) into the right side (P3) using a soft headed mallet. Attach 2 x right runner tracks (H12) to right side (P3) using 6 x small screws (H9), tightening with a phillips head screwdriver. Ensure you insert the screws (H9) into the holes on the tracks (H12) as shown.





Attach top panel rail (P4) to left side (P2) ensuring the hole on the rail (P4) is facing down as shown. Insert large cam nut (H2) into rail (P4) and rotate so the arrow points towards the incoming cam bolt. Turn the cam nut (H2) clockwise to lock.




Attach front support rail (P5) to left side (P2) ensuring the holes are facing down as shown. Insert 1 x large cam nut (H2) into support rail (P5) and rotate the cam nut so the arrow points towards the incoming cam bolt. Turn clockwise using a phillips head screwdriver to lock.




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


Attach back support rail (P6) to left side (P2), ensuring the holes are facing down as shown. Insert 1 x large cam nut (H2) into support rail (P6) and rotate so the cam nut so the arrow points towards the incoming cam bolt. Turn clockwise using a phillips head screwdriver to lock.





Attach right side (P3) to the rails (P4, P5, P6) and insert 1 x large cam nut (H2) into each rail (P4, P5, P6) as shown. Rotate the cam nuts (H2) so the arrows point towards the incoming cam bolt. Turn clockwise using a phillips head screw driver to lock.






Slide the back panel (P7) into the grooves on the left and right side (P2, P3).






Insert 4 x back panel support (H5) into each corner of the back panel (P7) and secure using 4 x medium screws (H6), tightening with a phillips head screwdriver.

Step 12




Attach 4 x small cam bolts (H17) to 1 x drawer front (P8) and tighten using a phillips head screwdriver. Repeat process for the other drawer front (P8).





Attach 1 x left drawer side (P9) and 1 x right drawer side (P10) to 1 x drawer front (P8), ensuring the grooves on all the panels align. Insert 2 x small cam nuts (H18) into drawer sides (P9. P10) rotating the cam nuts so the arrow points towards the incoming cam bolts. Turn clockwise to lock using a phillips head screwdriver. Repeat process for the other drawer




Slide drawer base (P12) into the grooves on the drawer sides (P9, P10) and drawer front (P8).

Repeat process for the other drawer.









Attach drawer back (P11) to drawer sides (P9, P10) using 4 x large screws (H10), tightening using a phillips head screwdriver. Repeat process for other drawer.


Step 16







Attach 1 x left runner (H13) and 1 x right runner (H14) to the bottom of drawer sides (P9, P10) using 3 x small screws (H9). Ensure you insert the screws into the holes as shown. Repeat process for the other drawer.




Slide the 2 x assembled drawers into the bedside table as shown.





We strongly advise that you use the wall safety strap provided to prevent the unit toppling.




Attach wall strap (H15) to back of the top panel (P1) using 1 x large screw (H10) and 1 x washer (H16).
