

Assembly Checklist



Read through the instructions carefully before you begin.



Make sure you have all the required tools. Never use power tools unless instructed.



Identify and lay out all of the components before you begin assembly.



Unless instructed, do not fully tighten screws until the item is fully assembled.

Useful Information

- ! Never use power tools unless specifically instructed. They can damage your components or hardware if used incorrectly.
- ! The most common mistakes made during assembly are using the wrong hardware or getting components back to front.
- ! Always use a soft surface (such as carpet or cardboard) when assembling your product to avoid scratching or damaging the surface of the product.
- ! Bulky items such as wardrobes and bunk beds should be assembled in the room they will be used in as they may not fit through a door once assembled.
- ! Never use any glue until you are certain that the parts belong together.
- ! Periodically check and re-tighten all fasteners. Check the product care label or website for product care instructions.
- ! If you are having any difficulties assembling your product, missing any hardware or components please visit our website Help Centre for further assistance.






Mallet; Phillips Head Screwdriver




Hardware Pack



Step 1





Insert 4 x wooden dowels into bottom support (P4). If necessary, gently tap the dowels into place with a mallet.

Step 2

You will need

4 x Screws (H1) Phillips Head Screwdriver


Note: Assemble the drawer on a soft flat surface to prevent unit from being damaged during assembly.

Position drawer sides (P2, P3) onto the drawer front (P1) as shown.

Make sure the grooves on drawer sides (P2, P3) are on the same side as drawer front (P1). Attach drawer sides (P2, P3) onto drawer front (P1) with 4 x screws (H1), using a phillips head screwdriver.

Make sure the drawer sides are aligned to the drawer front before tightening.



Step 3 Two People (P3) (P4) (P2)

Slide drawer bottom (P5) into the grooves on the drawer sides (P2, P3) and drawer front (P1), ensuring the side with the label is facing the same side as bottom support (P4). Position bottom support (P4) onto drawer front (P1) as shown. Position drawer back (P6) onto drawer sides (P2, P3), bottom support (P4) and drawer bottom (P5).





Attach drawer back (P6) to drawer sides (P2, P3) with 4 x screws (H1) using a phillips head screwdriver. Make sure the drawer back is aligned to drawer sides before tightening.








Attach bottom support (P4) to drawer front (P1) and drawer back (P6) with 3 x screws (H1) using a phillips head screwdriver.








Attach 4 x corner blocks (P7) to the corners of the assembled drawer (P1, P2, P3, P6) with 8 x screws (H1) using a phillips head screwdriver.

With help, carefully turn the storage drawer over and slide it under a Dalkeith bed.

Repeat Step 1-6 to assemble the other drawer.
