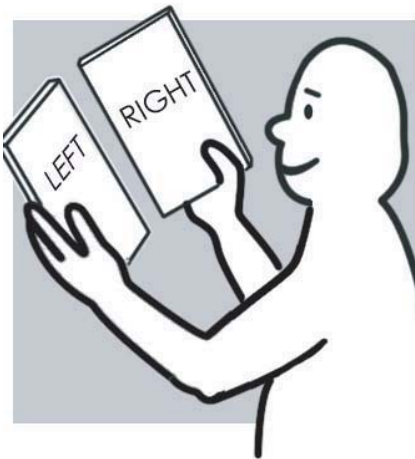
Read Instructions carefully.

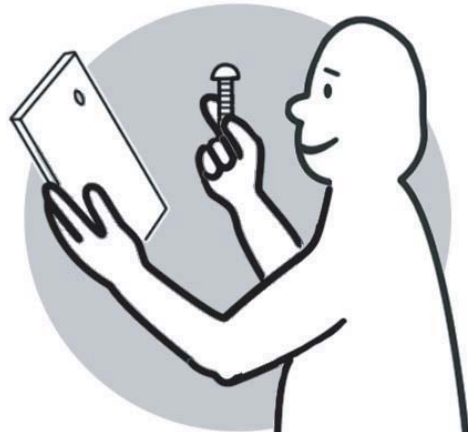
Lay out all of the components on a soft surface  
as if you were preparing to do a jigsaw puzzle.

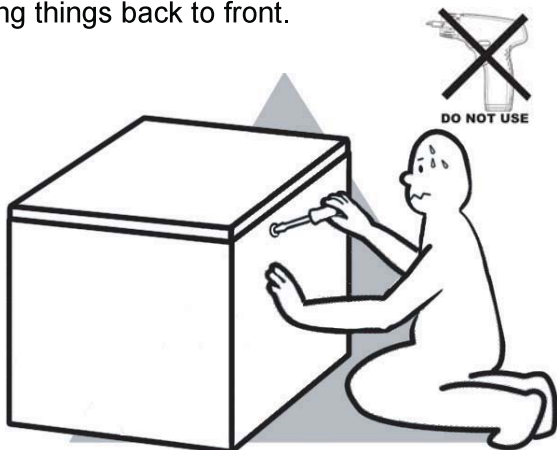
Carefully identify each component, especially  
those that are similar. The most common mistake  
is getting things back to front.

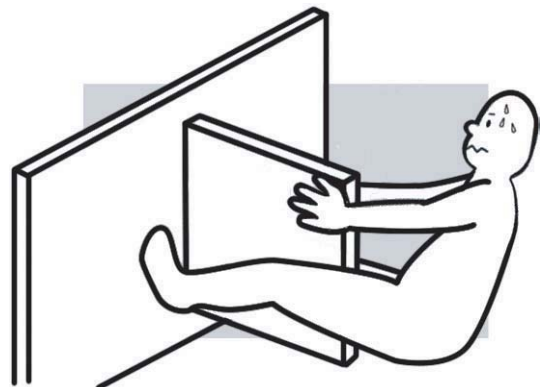
Separate and identify each component from the  
hardware pack and rest each one in its proper  
location before fastening.

**DO NOT** fully tighten screws (leave slightly  
loose). When the item is fully assembled  
tighten the screws - but do not over tighten.

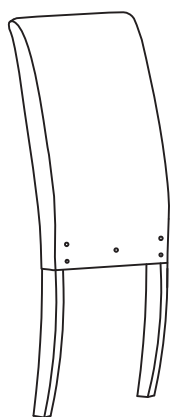
If glue is required **DO NOT** set until you are  
certain that the parts belong together.



# Step 1

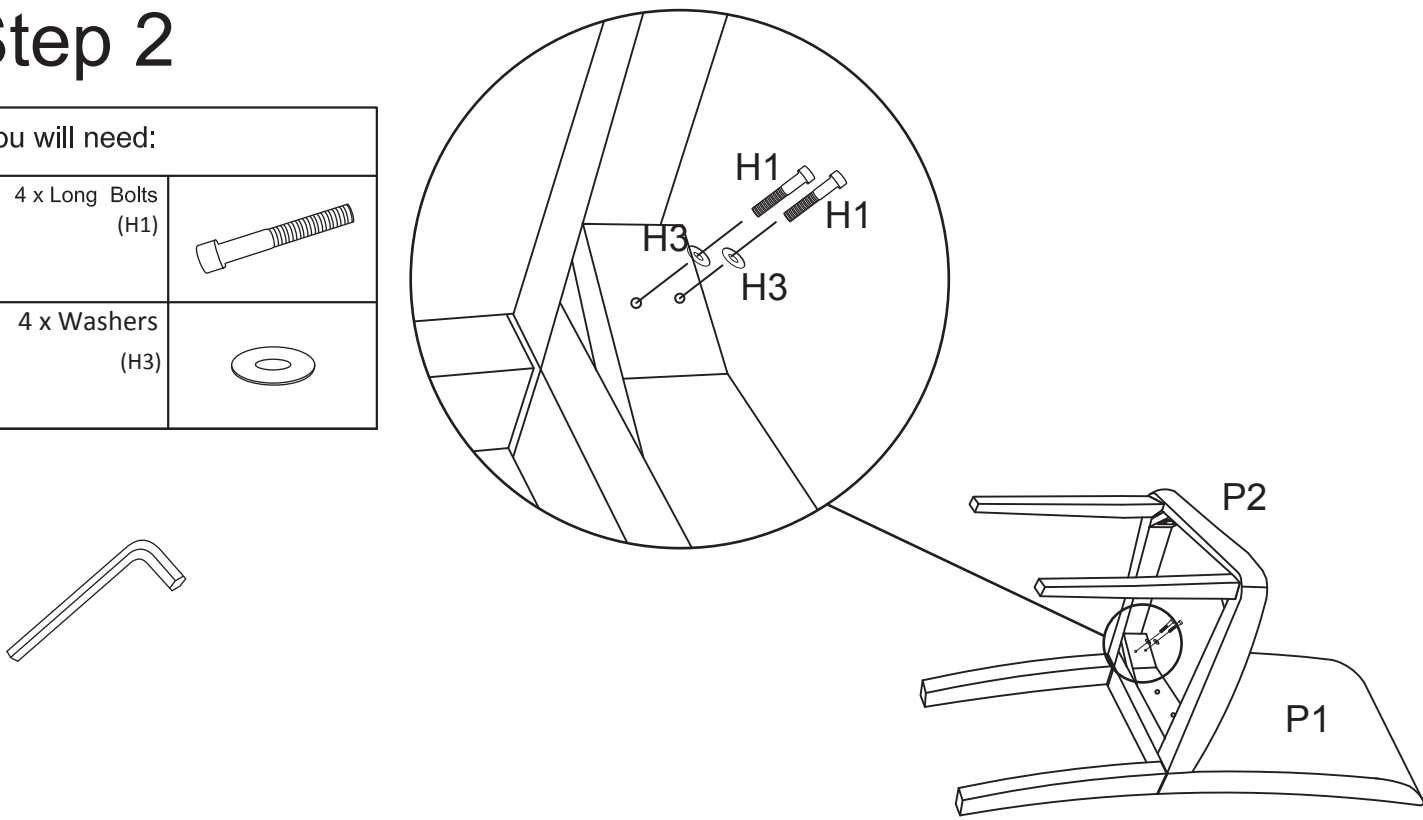
You will need:	
4 x Medium Bolts (H2)	
4 x Washers (H3)	



Insert Front Legs (P3) into the corresponding holes in Seat Frame (P2). Attach using 4 x Washers (H3) and 4 x Medium Bolts (H2). Do not fully tighten bolts, leave a little loose at this stage.



# Step 2

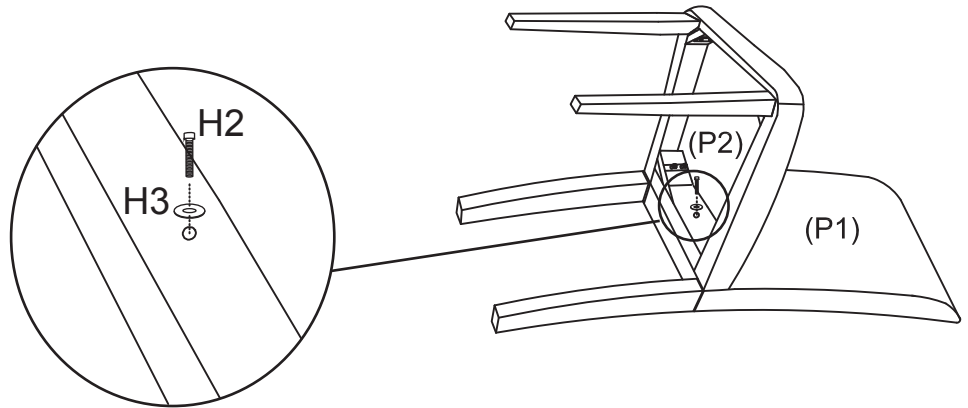
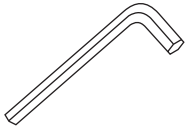
You will need:	
4 x Long Bolts (H1)	
4 x Washers (H3)	



Attach Seat Frame (P2) to Back Frame (P1) using 4 x Washers (H3) and 4 x Long Bolts (H1). Hand tighten to 80%.

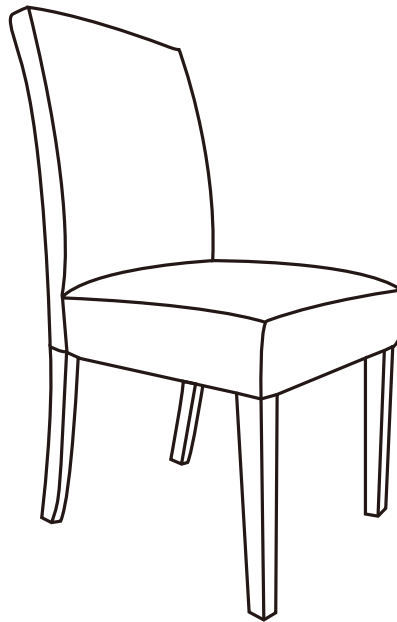
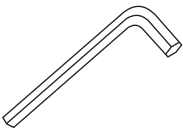
## Step 3

You will need:	
1 x Washer (H3)	
1 x medium Bolts (H2)	



Insert 1 x medium Bolt (H2) and 1x Washer (H3) and hand tighten to 80%.

## Step 4



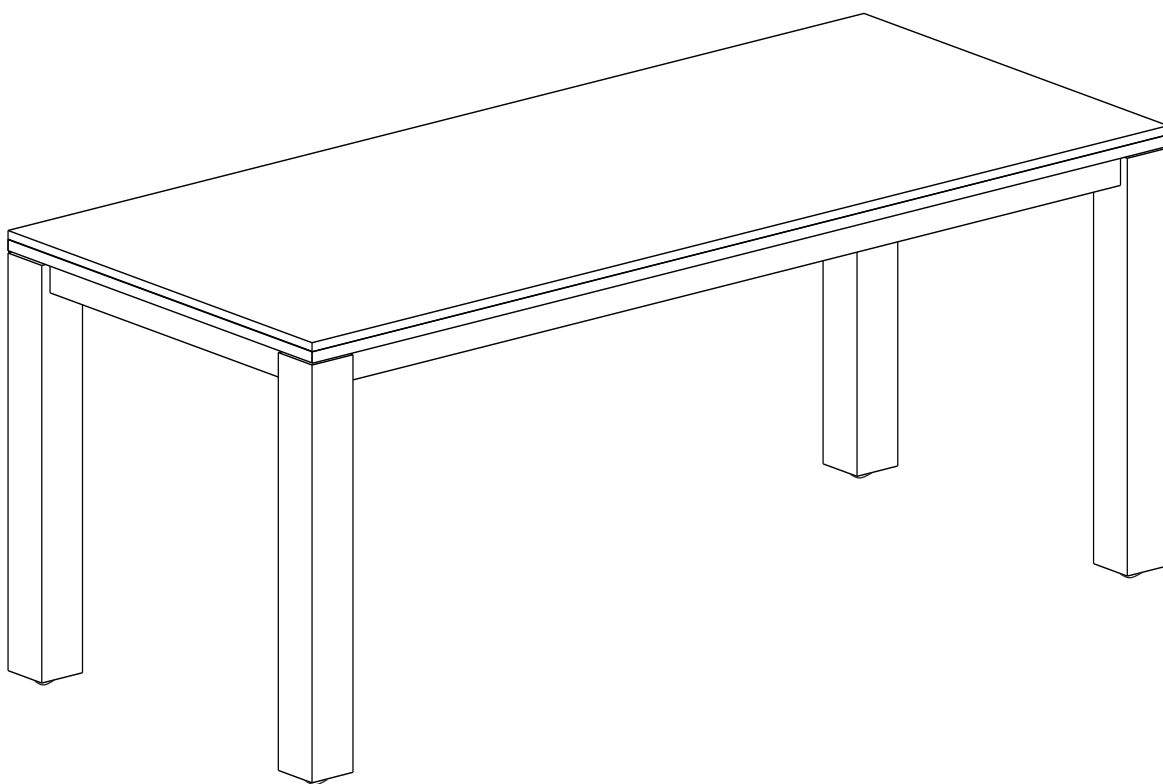
Apply downward pressure on the seat pad to ensure the chair is level before tightening all bolts firmly with Allen Key.

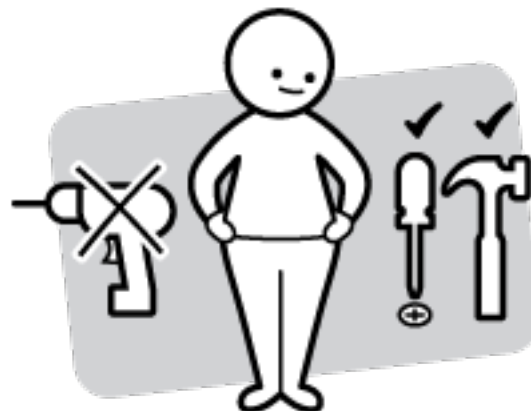

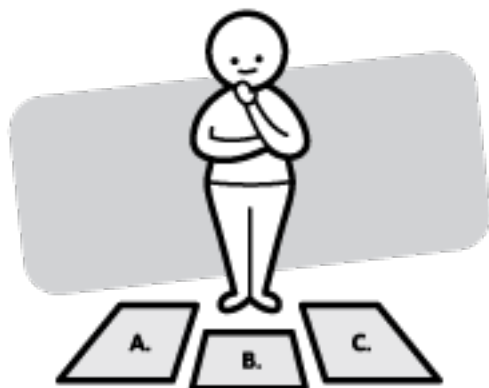
# Assembly checklist



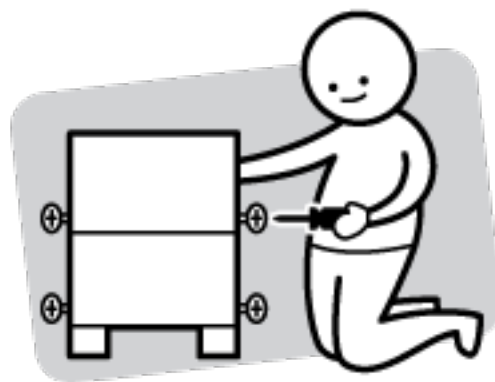
Read through the instructions carefully before you begin.



Make sure you have all the required tools. Never use power tools unless instructed.



Identify and lay out all of the components before you begin assembly.



Unless instructed, do not fully tighten screws until the item is fully assembled.

## Useful Information

! Never use power tools unless specifically instructed. They can damage your components or hardware if used incorrectly.

! The most common mistakes made during assembly are using the wrong hardware or getting components back to front.

! Always use a soft surface (such as carpet or cardboard) when assembling your product to avoid scratching or damaging the surface of the product.

! Bulky items such as wardrobes and bunk beds should be assembled in the room they will be used in as they may not fit through a door once assembled.

! Never use any glue until you are certain that the parts belong together.

! Periodically check and re-tighten all fasteners. Check the product care label or website for product care instructions.

! If you are having any difficulty assembling your product, missing any hardware or components please visit our website Help Centre for further assistance.

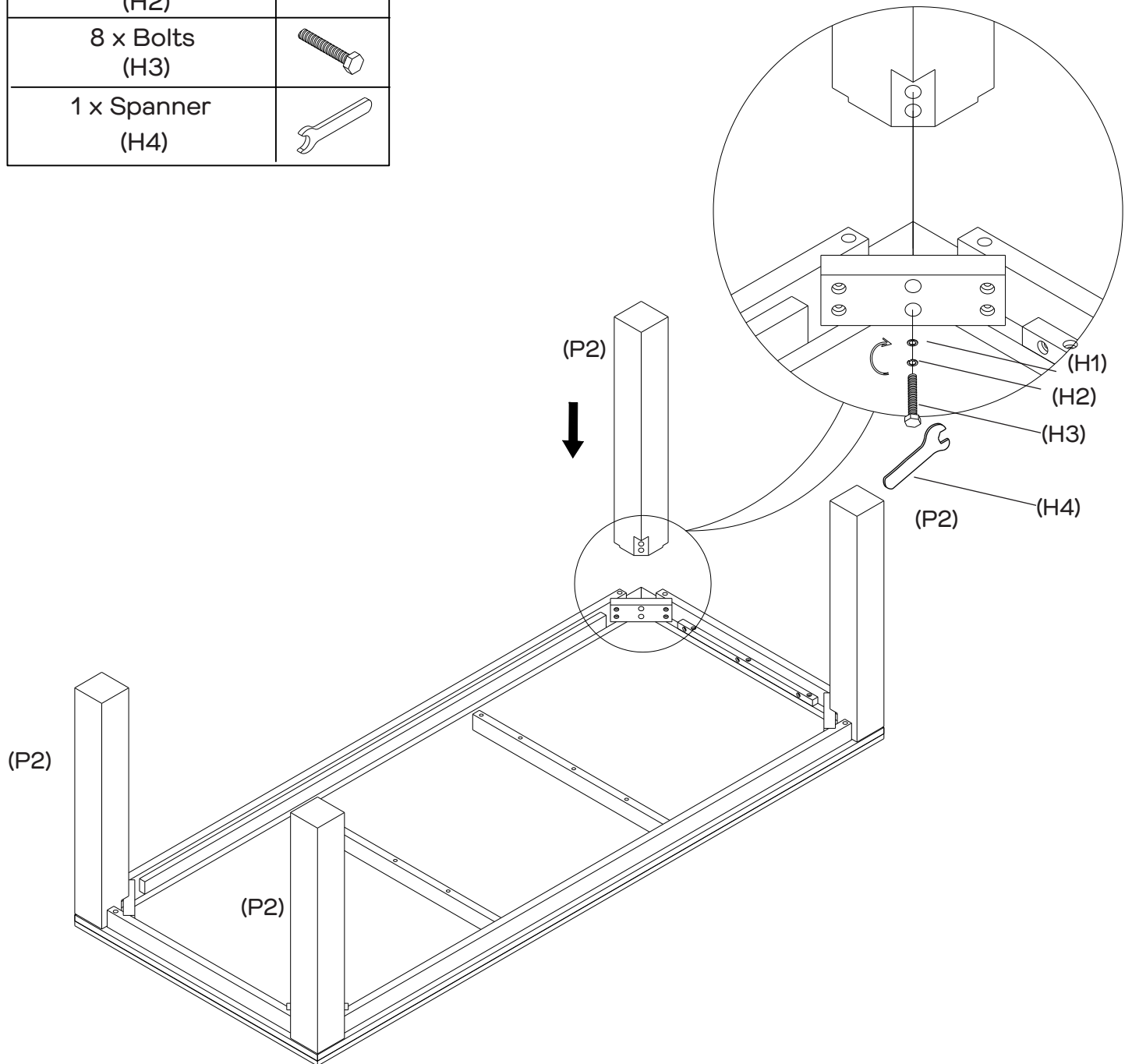
# Step 1

Required

You will need	
8 x Flat washers (H1)	
8 x Spring washers (H2)	
8 x Bolts (H3)	
1 x Spanner (H4)	



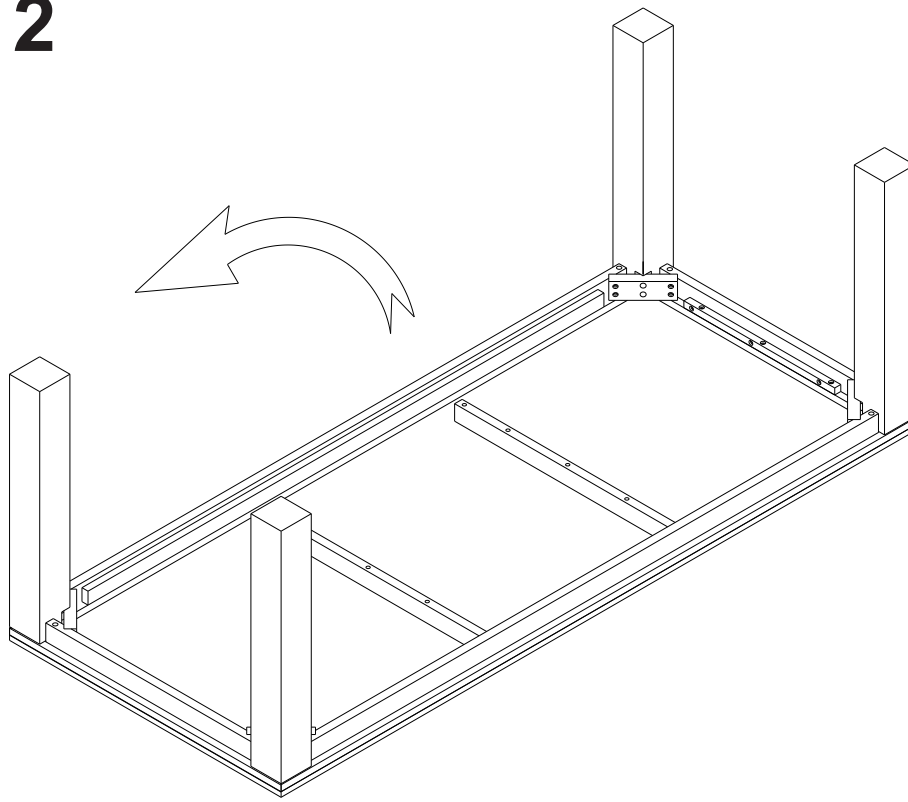
Lay table top panel (P1) upside down on a soft surface as to not damage the top.  
Put spring washer (H2) and then flat washer (H1) onto bolt (H3).  
Align the legs (P2) with table top (P1) and fix with bolt (H3).  
Use spanner (H4) to tighten.

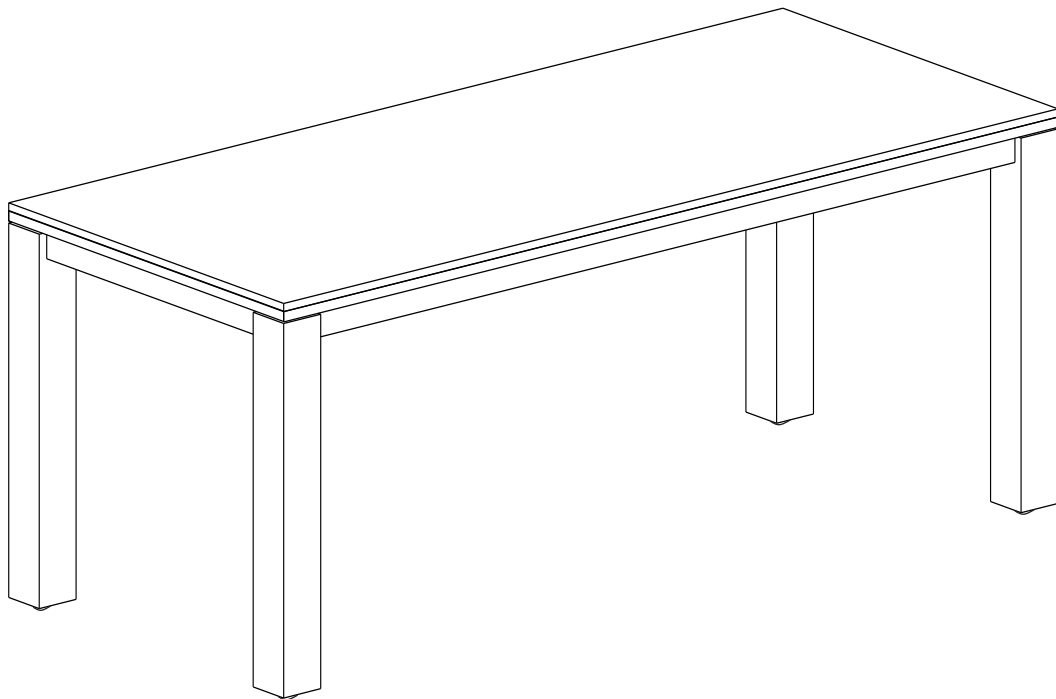
