#### Glass should always be handled with care.






Read through the instructions carefully before you begin.

## Useful information

- ! Never use power tools unless specifically instructed. They can damage your components or hardware if used incorrectly.
- ! The most common mistakes made during assembly are using the wrong hardware or getting components back to front.
- ! Always use a soft surface (such as carpet or cardboard) when assembling your product to avoid scratching or damaging the surface of the product.
- ! Bulky items such as wardrobes and bunk beds should be assembled in the room they will be used as they may not fit through a door once assembled.
- ! Never use any glue until you are certain that the parts belong together.
- ! Periodically check and re-tighten all fasteners. Check the product care label or website for product care instructions.

- ! Please see page 2 for any safety requirements or weight restrictions.






Attach the  $3 \times$  handles (H1) to the outside of the drawer using  $3 \times$  washer (H2) and  $3 \times$  bolts (H3) as shown.

Do not over tighten 3  $\times$  bolts (H3) as this will cause mirror face of the drawer to crack.








Attach the 8 x handles (H1) to the outside of the drawer using 8 x washer (H2) and 8 x bolts (H3) as shown.

Do not over tighten 8 x bolts (H3) as this will cause mirror face of the drawer to crack.

**Box 1 :** Footboard (P3) ; Side Rail (P4) ; Headboard Legs (P5) ; Footboard Legs (P6) ;

- Centre Rail (P7) ; Support Legs (P8) ; Timber Cross Rail (P9) ; End Connectors (P10) ; Centre Connectors (P11) ; Hardware Pack
- Box 2: Headboard (P1); Wing (P2-L); Wing (P2-R); Slats (P12)











Attach Wing (P2-L;P2-R) to the headboard (P1) with 4 x washers (H4) and 4 x Bolt 45mm (H3) by using Allen key (H2) as shown.

Step 2




Attach Headboard legs (P5) to the bottom of headboard (P1) as shown.






Attach footboard leg (P6) to the bottom of footboard (P3) with 4 x Large Screw 51mm (H6) by using phillips head screwdriver (not provided).


#### Step 4






Install the bolts (H1) to the brackets by using Allen key (H2) as shown, do not tighten the bolts and keep them 8 mm loose. Then attach side rails (P4) to headboard (P1) and footboard (P3) by slotting the bracket on the side rails (P4) over the bolt as shown. No need to tighten bolts until step 8.





Attach the support legs (P8) to the centre rail (P7) using  $2 \times Bolts$  (H5),  $2 \times Washers$  (H4) as shown.







Slot the centre raill (P7) into the headboard (P1) and footboard (P3) Rotate bolts (H5) by using phillips head screwdriver (not provided) to the headboard (P1) and footboard (P3). No need to tighten bolts until step 8.




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




Insert the full slat into the side rail and centre rail one by one.








Repeat for every bed slat until finished.






Make sure the inner space is square.

Attach the felt pad (H7) to the centre of centre rail (P7).

Then attach the timber cross rail (P9) to the centre of side rails (P4) by using 2 x screws (H8). Now tighten all the bolts on the corner bracket and tighten bolts on the headboard (P1) and footboard (P3).
