


Assembly Checklist



Read through the instruction carefully before you begin.



Make sure you have all the required tools. Never use power tools unless instructed.



Identify and lay out all of the components before you begin assembly.



Unless instructed, do not fully tighten screws until the item is full assembled.

Useful Information

! Never use power tools unless specifically instructed. They can damage your components or hardware if use incorrectly.

! The most common mistakes made during assembly are using the wrong hardware or getting components back to front.

! Always use a soft surface (such as carpet or cardboard) when assembling your products to avoid scratching or damaging the surface of product.

! Bulky items such as wardrobes and bunk beds should be assembled in the room they will be used in as they may not fit through a door once assembled.

! Never use any glue until you are certain that the parts belong together.

! Periodically check and re-tighten all fasteners. Check the product care label or website for product care instructions.



Other tools you need Phillips Head Screwdriver; Hammer.





Parts list

Carton 1: 2 x Side Rails (P3); Center Rail (P4); 15 x Slats (P5); 2 x Support Legs (P6).


Carton 2: Headboard (P1); Footboard (P2).

Hardware Pack







With assistance, turn the headboard (P1) and footboard (P2) upside down (bottom up). Using a phillips head screwdriver, loosen the 8 screws by turning anti-clockwise and remove the MDF brace.




Use a hammer to nail $4 \times \text{plastic}$ feet (H6) into the legs of the headboard (P1) and footboard (P2).








With assistance, align 2 x side rails (P3) to the headboard (P1) as shown. Attach side rails (P3) to the headboard (P1) using 4×10^{-2} x flat washers (H2). Tighten with allen key (H1).




With assistance, align footboard (P2) to 2 x side rails (P3) as shown. Attach side rails (P3) to the footboard (P2) using 4 x bolts (H3) and 4 x flat washers (H2). Tighten with allen key (H1). fantasticfurniture.com.au








With help, lift and move the bed to its final position. Place the centre rail (P4) in between the headboard (P1) and footboard (P2).






Attach the centre rail (P4) to the headboard (P1) and footboard (P2) using 2×1 large screws (H4), tightening with a phillips head screwdriver.




Extend the adjusters on the 2 x support legs (P6) so that they are 10mm above the floor.






Lay the slats (P5) onto the assembled bed frame. Attach the slats (P5) to the $2 \times \text{side}$ rails (P3) and centre rail (P4) using $45 \times \text{small}$ screws (H5), fully tightening with phillips head screwdriver.

Step 10






Extend the adjuster until it is 10mm above the floor.

If you need to move the bed to a different position, please follow the steps below to avoid any damage to the bed and the floor. At least two people are needed here.

- 1. Remove the mattress and all bedding items.
- 2. Fully retract the adjusters on the 2 x centre rail support legs.
- 3. Lift and move the bed to the new position.
- 4. Extend the adjuster on the centre rail support legs so that they are 10mm above the floor.
- 5. Replace the mattress.
