







GLASS SHOULD ALWAYS BE HANDLED WITH CARE

Scratches, chips, sudden changes in temperature and hairline fractures may cause the glass to break. This glass is designed to break into small, relatively harmless pieces and not sharp fragments.

Avoid placing hot or cold items directly onto the table unless using a thick insulation material such as placemats or coasters.

Avoid dropping objects onto the glass. Do not allow hard or pointed objects to come into contact with the glass. Never use the top area as a chopping surface. Do not sit or stand on the glass surface.

Assembly checklist




Read through the instructions carefully before you begin.



Identify and lay out all of the components before you begin assembly.



Make sure you have all the required tools. Never use power tools unless instructed.



Unless instructed, do not fully tighten screws until the item is fully assembled.


Useful Information

- ! Never use power tools unless specifically instructed. They can damage your components or hardware if used incorrectly
- ! The most common mistakes made during assembly are using the wrong hardware or getting components back to front.
- ! Always use a soft surface (such as carpet or cardboard) when assembling your product to avoid scratching or damaging the surface of the product.
- ! Bulky items such as wardrobes and bunk beds should be assembled in the room they will be used in as they may not fit through a door once assembled.
- ! Never use any glue until you are certain that the parts belong together.
- ! Periodically check and re-tighten all fasteners. Check the product care label or website for product care instructions.


Box 1: Large legs (P1), Small legs (P2), center block (P3), Cap (P4), Cap (P5), Top (P6)








Attach adjustable feet (H5) to legs (P1 and P2).



and Allen key (H8). Make sure large legs (P1) and small legs (P2) are in correct sequence before tightning bolts. Be aware to only tighten bolts 80%, you will fully tighten these in step 4.








Lay glass table top on to a soft flat surface to avoid damaging the glass. Attach legs (P1 and P2) to top (P6) by using bolts (H3) and allen key (H6). Make sure to align all bolts well, before fully tightening.






Make sure the table is level, then fully tighten all bolts (H2) by using allen key (H8).






Add Metal stick (H1) to Center block (P3), and attach Caps (P4 and P5). Tighten the Caps (P4 and P5) by using nuts (H4) and Spanner (H7).



Carefully turn the table to its upright position. Adjust height by adjusting feet.





Box 1: 1 x Seat (P1); 1 x Base (P2); 4 x Leg (P3)


Hardware pack





Place the $4 \times legs$ (P3) in position of the base (P2) as shown

Step 2




Mount the 4 x legs (P3) to the base (P2) using bolts (H1), washers (H4), metal head (H3), big allen key (H5) and small allen key (H6)










Mount the base (P2) to the seat (P1) using bolts (H2), washers (H4) and big allen key (H5). Attach felt pads (H7) to the legs.
