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
Assembly Checklist




Read through instructions carefully before you begin



Make sure you have all the required tools. Never use power tools unless instructed.




Identify and lay out all of the components before you begin assembly.



Unless Instructed, do not fully tighten screws until the item is fully assembled.

Useful Information

- ! Never use power tools unless specifically instructed. They can damage your components or hardware if used incorrectly.
- ! The most common mistake made during assembly are using the wrong hardware or getting components back to front.
- ! Always use a soft surface (such as carpet or cardboard) when assembling your product to avoid scratching or damaging the surface of the product.
- ! Bulky items such as wardrobes and bunk beds should be assembled in the room they will be used as they may not fit through a door once assembled.
- ! Never use any glue until you are certain that the parts belong together.
- ! Periodically check and re-tighten all fasteners. Check the product care label or website for product care instructions.





Align the bolt holes on seat frame (P2) to chair back (P1), and attach with 2 x short bolts (H3), 2 x spring washers (H5) and 2 x flat washers (H4), using allen key (H8). Do not fully tighten the bolts until Step 6.




Further secure seat frame (P2) to chair back (P1) using 4×1000 bolts (H1), 4×1000 spring washers (H5) and 4×1000 fully tighten the bolts until Step 6.












Sit the assembled frame (P1, P2) onto a table with the back legs facing up. Slot $1 \times \text{side}$ stretcher (P5) into the left leg of the chair back (P1). Attach $1 \times \text{front}$ leg left (P3L) to the side stretcher (P5). Then attach front leg left (P3L) to the seat frame (P2) using $2 \times \text{medium}$ bolts (H2), $2 \times \text{spring}$ washers (H5) and $2 \times \text{flat}$ washers (H4) with allen key (H8). Tighten bolts so parts are secure but ensure they are not fully tightened until Step 6.



Slot 1 x side stretcher (P5) into the right leg of the chair back (P1). Slot 1 x front stretcher (P6) into the front leg left (P3L). Attach the front stretcher (P6) and the side stretcher (P5) to the 1 x front leg right (P3R) then attach front leg right (P3R) to the seat frame (P2) using 2 x medium bolts (H2), 2 x spring washers (H5), 2 x flat washers (H4) with allen key (H8). Tighten bolts so parts are secure but ensure they are not fully tightened until Step 6.

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

Carefully turn the chair upright and place on a flat surface.

Make adjustments by sitting on the chair to ensure the chair frame is straight and legs are even on the floor then fully tighten all bolts.

Stick the 4 x felt covers (H9) onto the bottom of the 4 x legs.







Attach 1 x table leg (P2) to table top (P1) with 2 x long bolts (H1), 2 x spring washers (H3) and 2 x flat washers (H4) using allen key (H5). Do not fully tighten the bolts until Step 5.



Slot 1 x bottom stretcher (P3) into the table leg (P2) attached to the table top (P1). Slot the other end of the bottom stretcher (P3) into 1 x table leg (P2) and secure the table leg (P2) to the table top (P1) with 2 x long bolts (H1), 2 x spring washers (H3) and 2 x flat washers (H4) using allen key (H5). Do not fully tighten the bolts until Step 5.








Slot the bottom stretcher (P4) into the slot on bottom stretcher (P3) as shown. Secure the bottom stretchers (P3 & P4) together using 1 x short bolt (H2) and allen key (H5). Do not fully tighten the bolts until Step 5.






Slot the bottom stretcher (P4) into 2 \times table legs (P2). Attach the 2 \times table legs (P2) to table top (P1) and secure with 4 \times long bolts (H1), 4 \times spring washers (H3) and 4 \times flat washers (H4), with allen key (H5). Do not fully tighten the bolts until Step 5.








Secure bottom stretchers (P3 & P4) to the $4 \times \text{table legs}$ (P2) with $4 \times \text{screws}$ (H7) using a phillips head screwdriver. Fully tighten all the bolts.


