

# Product Care & Maintenance



## Glass

**We want you to enjoy your Fantastic Furniture for as long as possible, with simple care and maintenance you will extend the life of your furniture.**

Glass is breakable, always handle with care. Scratches, chips, sudden changes in temperature, hairline fractures or other minor impurities may cause the glass to break suddenly and without warning.

For general maintenance dust regularly to prevent dirt build up. Use a damp cloth for general cleaning or to remove finger prints and smudges use glass cleaning products according to the manufacturer's instructions. Never use caustic or abrasive cleaning agents and do not use silicone based cleaning products.

Be careful to avoid dragging sharp and hard objects over any glass surface. Do not place very hot or very cold items directly on the glass; instead use table clothes, coasters or heat resistant mats.

Check all your furniture hardware (screws, nuts and bolts) to make sure they are not loose and tighten regularly to help keep the product looking its best for years to come. These care instructions are a general guide – for any specific instructions check your product care label.

## Polyurethane Lacquer

**We want you to enjoy your Fantastic Furniture for as long as possible, with simple care and maintenance you will extend the life of your furniture.**

For general maintenance dust regularly to avoid dust build up. Use a clean damp non abrasive cloth with warm mild soapy water, this will remove stubborn stains. Avoid using scouring pads and abrasive cleaners as this will cause scratches. Always clean stains and spills immediately otherwise you risk damaging the lacquer.

Use heat protecting mats for hot items. Tablecloths, placements and coaster are recommended to protect against general wear and tear.

Check all your furniture hardware (screws, nuts and bolts) to make sure they are not loose and tighten regularly to help keep the product looking its best for years to come.
